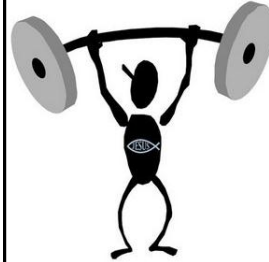


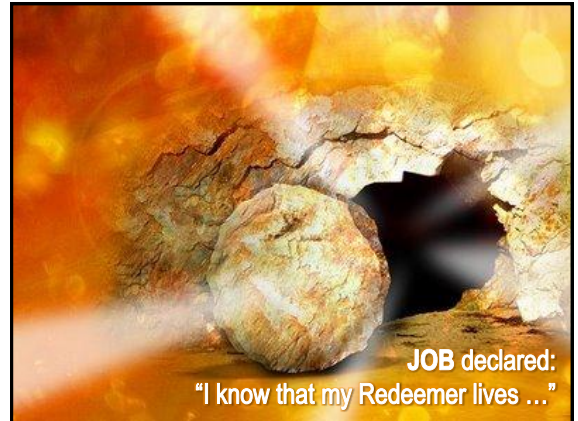
2. Say what you know



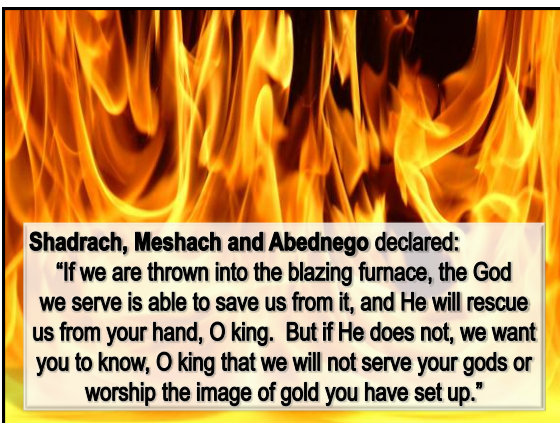
PAUL declared:
