






I. Why is there lack in the world?Because of the <u>Fallen-ness</u> of Man.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ...


John 16:33b In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

2 Timothy 3:1-4

1 But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: 2 For men will be <u>lovers of themselves</u>, <u>lovers of money</u>, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, 3 <u>unloving</u>, <u>unforgiving</u>, slanderers, without self-control, <u>brutal</u>, despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, <u>lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God</u>...

II. Why is there lack even amongst believers?

1. Ignorance of the **Word** of God re Laws of Provision.

Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children.

Isaiah 5:13 Therefore my people have gone into **captivity**, **because they have no knowledge**; their honourable men are **famished**, and their multitude **dried up with thirst**.





Malachi 3:8-9 8 "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings. 9 You are cursed with a curse, For you have robbed Me, even this whole nation.

Proverbs 6:10-11

A. Compromising with <u>evil</u>


Proverbs 13:11a <u>Wealth gained by</u>







Malachi 3:10-11

unknown men.



1 Timothy 6:17 Command those who are rich in this present age not to be haughty, **nor to trust in uncertain**riches but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.

Guard <u>Greed</u> and <u>Covetousness</u> in our hearts.

B. The love of money is **Covetousness** and **Covetousness** is idolatry.


Colossians 3:5 Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and <u>Covetousness</u>, <u>which is idolatry</u>.



4. Guard Greed and Covetousness in our hearts.

C. The love of money is a temptation and snare leading to destruction.

1 Timothy 6:9 But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a **Snare**, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in **destruction** and perdition.




- **4.** Guard <u>Greed</u> and <u>Covetousness</u> in our hearts.

Matthew 13:22 Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the <u>deceitfulness of</u>
<u>riches choke the word</u>, and he becomes unfruitful.

Proverbs 23:4-5 (NIV)

- 4 Do not wear yourself out to get rich; do not trust your own cleverness.
- **5** Cast but a glance at riches, and they are gone, for they will surely sprout wings and fly off to the sky like an eagle.



5. Be rooted and established in the **Father's Love**.

1 John 2:15-16

15 <u>Do not love the world or the things in the world</u>. If anyone loves the world, the <u>love of the Father</u> is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

Bottom-Line: The Story of Elijah and the Widow of Zarephath

1 Kings 17:13-16 (NIV)

13 Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small loaf of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. 14 For this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord sends rain on the land." 15 She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. 16 For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah.
