





A. No Offenses - Unoffendable

Luke 8:18a - take heed how you hear.

Acts 22:9 - everyone saw the light but only Paul heard the voice of God.
- Same message heard by all but Holy Spirit will speak direct Rhema.

Core-values for an effective CG:

A. No **Offenses** - Unoffendable

- i. Personality differences
- ii. Work style clashes
- iii. Miscommunication - under communication
- iv. Unable to differentiate views on an issue vs taking it personally
- v. Expectations not met
- vi. Careless words - just comes out wrongly


