





- Same message heard by all but Holy Spirit will speak direct Rhema.

- A. No Offenses Unoffendable
 - Common offenses:
 - i. Personality differences

 - iv. Unable to differentiate views on an issue vs taking it personally
 - v. Expectations not met
 - vi. Careless words just comes out wrongly

- B. Accountability & Covering and Praying & Communicating


