








When Jesus was baptized, 3 things happened:


- 1. The heaven was <u>opened</u>.

- 3. Jesus <u>pleased</u> i.e. brought <u>delight</u> to Father-God.
















 ii. He must <u>believe</u> God, <u>appropriate</u> i.e. apply and obey the Word in order to <u>receive</u> the grace that we need.



























- D. The anointing upon i.e. to be filled with the Holy Spirit is to receive the enabling and empowering of the Holy Spirit on the life of the believer to:






- the Holy Spirit on the life of the believer to:
