


- 1. The Infinite yet Personal God desires a Personal Relationship with us.

3 John 2

Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in [bodily] health, just as your soul prospers.

The 5 factors that affect our bodily health:-

- (A) Our Genes / Our Bodily Constitution
- (B) Our Diet
- (c) Our Resideep
- (D) Our Exercise
- (E) The State of Our Soul

- 1. Praying for our **Bodily** Health.
 - · Ailments, Sickness, Disease.
 - · Always determine re root causes.
 - 70-80% of sickness and disease have a soul-spirit root cause.
 - The other 20-30% are due to a violation of the physical natural aws affecting our bodies.

Unworthy Manner

- and statistics appropriate DIVINE HEALING and statistics our bodily a ments, sickness and markets and scalars comforts

Otherwise, we remain weak and sick, no different from the people of the world. (due to the fall of man and fallen natural laws)

If we fail to discern the Lord's Body i.e. we fail to appropriate the healing that is available to us through partaking the Bread.

- 2. Apply the "Oil" "Ointment" of the Holy Spirit to the wounded areas of our soul.

 - · Jeremiah 8:22 Balm of Gilead
