


Luke 1:15-17


3. Turn the disobedient to the wisdom of the just.

Parable of the Sower and the Seed








Matthew 7:24-25



1. Know we are **significant** in the eyes of the Lord.

HOW



A. We must be <u>secured / rooted</u> in the Father's love.

1 John 2:15-16

15 Do not <u>love the world</u> or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the <u>love of the Father</u> is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.



B. We must be **perfected** in the Father's love.

1 John 4:18 There is no fear in love; but <u>perfect</u> love casts out fear, because fear involves torment. But he who fears has not been <u>made</u> <u>perfect in love</u>.





C. We must deal with **personal baggage**.

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us ...

2. We must be **separated**.

2. We must be <u>separated</u>.
Separation FROM everything that hinders the fulfilling of God's Purpose
Separation TO everything that value-add to the fulfilling of God's call

Relationships-Activities-Hobbies-Attitudes, etc.

How you spend \$, time, energy, resources, etc.
