Crossing the River Jordan

Then Joshua rose early in the morning; and they set out from Acacia Grove and came to the Jordan, he and all the children of Israel, and lodged there before they crossed over. ²So it was, after three days, that the officers went through the camp;

3and they commanded the people, saying, "When you see the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests, the Levites, bearing it, then you shall set out from your place and go after it.

4Yet there shall be a space Between you and it, about two thousand cubits by measure. Do not come near it, that you may know the way by which you must go, for you have not passed this way before."

Then Joshua spoke to the priests, saying, "Take up the Ark of the Covenant and cross over before the people."

with Moses, so I will be with you.

8You shall command the priests who bear the Ark of the Covenant, saying, 'When you have come to the edge of the water of the Jordan, you shall stand in the Jordan."

So Joshua said to the children of Israel, "Come here, and hear the Words of the LORD your God."

10And Joshua said, "By this you shall know that the Living God is among you, and that He will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Hivites and the Perizzites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Jebusites:

11Behold, the Ark of the Covenant of the Lord of all the earth is crossing over before you into the Jordan.
12Now therefore, take for yourselves twelve men from the tribes of Israel, one man from every tribe.

¹³And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests who bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of the Jordan, that the waters of the Jordan shall be cut off, the waters that come down from upstream, and they shall stand as a heap."

14So it was, when the people set out from their camp to cross over the Jordan, with the priests bearing the Ark of the Covenant before the people,

15and as those who bore the ark came to the Jordan, and the feet of the priests who bore the ark dipped in the edge of the water (for the Jordan overflows all its banks during the whole time of harvest)

16that the waters which came down from upstream stood still, and rose in a heap very far away at Adam, the city that is beside Zaretan. So the waters that went down into the Sea of the Arabah, the Salt Sea, failed, and were cut off; and the people crossed over opposite Jericho.

17Then the priests who bore the Ark of the Covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of the Jordan; and all Israel crossed over on dry ground, until all the people had crossed completely over the Jordan.

- The Promised Land was the Goal.
- When the Israelites left Egypt, they were looking forward to their dream of a <u>Land Flowing with</u> <u>Milk and Honey</u>.

- The Journey to the Promised Land was not easy.
- The 12 spies (Numbers 13 14)
- Unbelief caused the Israelites
 to wander in the desert for 40 years.
 [Hebrews 3 4]

- Except for <u>Joshua</u>, <u>Caleb</u> and all the <u>men born in the wilderness</u>, the rest of the men who came out of Egypt died in the wilderness, Moses being the last.
- Joshua and Caleb
 - followed God fully
 - Men of a different spirit

- They now stand at the bank of the <u>Jordan River</u> looking across to the Promised Land.
- The <u>Jordan River</u> is the line separating the Israelites from the Promised Land.
- To reach the Promised Land, they had to cross the <u>River Jordan</u>.

- Most of the year, the <u>Jordan River</u>
 was only a mere stream that was easily
 forded.
- However, during the harvest season, the river transformed from a small stream into a mighty river that would overflow and flood the surrounding plain.

Guess WHEN God chose for the Israelites to cross the River?

At the **FLOOD STAGE** !!!

Will this generation cross over?

OR

Will they be as rebellious as their fathers had been?
