REVIEW: CROSSING THE RIVER JORDAN

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.



¹So it was, when <u>all the kings of the Amorites</u> who were on the west side of the Jordan, and all the kings of the Canaanites who were by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of the Jordan from before the children of Israel until we had crossed over, that their heart melted; and there was no spirit in them any longer because of the children of Israel.

²At that time the LORD said to Joshua,
"Make <u>flint knives</u> for yourself, and <u>circumcise</u>
the sons of Israel again the second time."

³So Joshua made flint knives for himself,
and circumcised the sons of Israel
at the hill of the foreskins.

⁴And this is the reason <u>why</u> Joshua circumcised them: All the people who came out of Egypt who were <u>males</u>, all the men of war, had <u>died in the wilderness</u> on the way, after they had come out of Egypt.

For all the people who came out had been circumcised, but all the people born in the wilderness, on the way as they came out of Egypt, had not been circumcised.

⁶For the children of Israel walked forty years in the wilderness, till all the people who were men of war, who came out of Egypt, were consumed, because they did not obey the voice of the LORD— to whom the LORD swore that He would not show them the land which the LORD had sworn to their fathers that He would give us, "a land flowing with milk and honey."

⁷Then Joshua circumcised their sons whom He raised up in their place; for they were uncircumcised, because they had not been circumcised on the way. 8So it was, when they had finished circumcising all the people, that they stayed in their places in the camp till they were healed.

Then the LORD said to Joshua, "This day I have rolled away the reproach of Egypt from you."

Therefore the name of the place is called Gilgal to this day.

I. BACKGROUND - Situation:-

- Israel has now crossed the River Jordan.
- The Canaanite Nations were totally terrified, demoralized and resigned to their fate.
- It would appear to be the perfect time for Joshua and Israel to attack.

I. BACKGROUND - Situation:-

- Instead, God commanded them to stay at Gilgal.
- It appeared that this stay at Gilgal will put them at risk before the enemy.
- The Ways of the Lord may seem strange.
- God is always right on time.

I. BACKGROUND - Situation:-

- Ours is not to argue what God wants us to do but to be obedient.
- God never gets into a hurry.
- In reality, God was preparing the army to fight.
- It was to be a Spiritual Battle first before the Physical Battle.

II. WHY CUT THE FLESH?

Genesis 17:10 - 11

¹⁰This is My Covenant which you shall keep, between Me and you and your descendants after you: Every male child among you shall be circumcised; ¹¹and you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskins, and it shall be a Sign of the Covenant between Me and you.

II. WHY CUT THE FLESH?

1. **RENEWING** their Covenant with God.

1. **RENEWING** their Covenant with God.

- God reminded Israel that all the men born in the wilderness had to be circumcised.
- This was a sign of their covenant with God.
- The cutting of the flesh is the sign to remove those things that stand between God and us.
- To the Jews, circumcision was a reminder that they were a "Marked People."

II. WHY CUT THE FLESH?

- 1. RENEWING their Covenant with God.
- 2. **REAFFIRMING** their Confidence in the LORD.

Joshua 5:8

So it was, when they had <u>finished</u>
<u>circumcising</u> all the people,
that they <u>stayed</u> in their places in the camp
<u>till they were healed</u>.

2. **REAFFIRMING** their Confidence in the LORD.

- At this time, Israel was camped in the midst of enemy territory.
- After the men were circumcised, they were temporarily unable to fight.
- So it took <u>Great Faith</u> to obey God.
- They had to demonstrate their faith and confidence in God to protect them.

II. WHY CUT THE FLESH?

- 1. RENEWING their Covenant with God.
- 2. **REAFFIRMING** their Confidence in the LORD.
- 3. **REMOVING** their Condemnation by the LORD.

Joshua 5:9

Then the LORD said to Joshua,

"This day I have <u>rolled away the reproach</u>

<u>of Egypt from you</u>."

Therefore the name of the place is called Gilgal to this day.

REPROACH OF EGYPT

Two events that nearly invoked God's Judgment to destroy Israel:-

- a. When they made the **GOLDEN CALF**. (Exodus 32)
- b. When they refused to **ENTER** the Promised Land at Kadesh-Barnea.

(Numbers 13 - 14)

3. **REMOVING** their Condemnation by the LORD.

- On both occasions, God threatened to destroy Israel.
- Up to this point in Gilgal, they were still under reproach (condemnation).

III. LESSON PRINCIPLES

1. Know what is the **FLESH** in our lives.

The Flesh in our lives is:

in the natural, no different from the non-believer.

Giving in to the lust of the eyes and ignoring the voice of the conscience e.g. indulging in pornography.

Not aware at all of the spiritual and the supernatural until something major happens.

Not vigilant, unguarded and giving in to the lust of the flesh e.g. committing adultery, fornication, stealing, lying...

Galatians 5:19 – 21

¹⁹Now the <u>works of the flesh</u> are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, ²⁰idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies,

Galatians 5:19 – 21

²¹envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the Kingdom of God.

It is the operation of the Law of Sin and Death.

III. LESSON PRINCIPLES

- 1. Know what is the **FLESH** in our lives.
- 2. Know and acknowledge the **HOLY**SPIROTIVE the Spiritual Life.

This begins when we believe and receive Christ Jesus as Savior and Lord of our lives.

John 1:12

But as many as <u>received Him</u>, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His Name ...

Romans 10:9 - 10

9that if you <u>confess</u> with your mouth the Lord Jesus and <u>believe</u> in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

¹⁰For with the heart one <u>believes</u> unto righteousness, and with the mouth <u>confession</u> is made unto salvation.

John 3:3, 5

³Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born again**, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

⁵Jesus answered, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is **born of water and the Spirit**, he cannot enter the Kingdom of God.

¹There is therefore now **no condemnation** to those who are in Christ Jesus, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. ²For the law of the Spirit of Life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death. 3For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God did by sending His own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, on account of sin: He condemned sin in the flesh

Therefore, having been justified by faith, we have **peace with God** through our Lord Jesus Christ.

²⁴And let us consider one another in order to <u>stir up</u> <u>love and good works</u>, ²⁵not forsaking the <u>assembling</u> of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but <u>exhorting</u> one another, and <u>so much the more</u> as you see the Day approaching.

Confidence and boldness to <u>LIVE</u> and to <u>SERVE</u> God

This is Opposite from the Situation of:

1 Corinthians 3:1 – 4

¹And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to <u>carnal</u>, as to <u>babes</u> <u>in Christ</u>. ²I fed you with <u>milk</u> and <u>not with solid food</u>; for until now you were <u>not able</u>;

Confidence and boldness to <u>LIVE</u> and to <u>SERVE</u> God

This is Opposite from the Situation of:

1 Corinthians 3:1 – 4

are you not <u>carnal</u> and behaving like <u>mere men</u>?

4For when one says, "I am of Paul," and another,

Apollos," are you not <u>carnal</u>?

CONCLUSION

Romans 2:28 – 29

²⁸For he is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision that which is outward in the flesh;
²⁹but he is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is that of the heart, in the Spirit, not in the letter; whose praise is not from men but from God.

CONCLUSION

Ephesians 4:22 – 24 ²²that you put off [cut the flesh], concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, 23 and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, 24 and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
