Wessage Summary

Spiritual Objective: Understanding how we ought to live in the end-times

We are living in the end-times. In such a time, it is important to think as Jesus thought, follow God's will and walk in holiness. How we live our lives today will matter in the life to come. The speaker lays out seven ways in which we can discipline ourselves in the light of our situation.

1. Be <u>Clear-Minded</u> and <u>Self-Controlled</u> so that we can <u>Pray</u>.

The <u>First</u> thing we must always do is <u>Connect</u> to God in <u>Prayer</u> (1 Peter 4:7)
To have a <u>Good</u> connect with God i.e. to pray <u>Effectively</u>, we must be <u>Clear</u>-minded (1 John 5:14=15)

3. To have a <u>Good</u> connect with God i.e. to pray <u>Effectively</u>, we must have <u>Self-Control</u> (2 Timothy 1:7)

2. Love each other Deeply because love Covers a multitude of sins. (1 Peter 4:8)

1. Love needs to cover a multitude of sins because we are all on the <u>Journey</u> to grow into Christ-likeness. (Romans 3:23)

2. In this journey towards Christ-likeness, we are still sorting out some <u>Baggage</u> that hinders. (Hebrews 12:1)

3. In this journey towards Christ-likeness, we are still sorting out the <u>Sin</u> that entangles. (Hebrews 12:1)

4. By our love for one another, we testify to the world that we are disciples of Christ. (John 13:34-35)

3. Be <u>Hospitable</u> to one another without <u>Grumbling</u>. (1 Peter 4:9)

4. Serve one another with our gifting. (1 Peter 4:9, Romans 12:4-13)

5. When we speak, do so as one speaking the very Words of God. (1 Peter 4:11a)

1. The mouth speaks from the overflow of the <u>Heart.</u> (Matthew 12:34b)

- 2. We must therefore guard out <u>Heart</u>. (Proverbs 4:23)
- 3a. Fill our hearts richly with the Word of God. (Colossians 3:16a)

3b. We will then be filled with Wisdom. (Colossians 3:16b)

3c. We will then be filled with the <u>Love</u> of <u>God</u> overflowing into thanksgiving, praise and worship. (Colossians 3:16c)

4. God will confirm His Word and counsel through You. (Isaiah 44:26a)

6. When we serve, we should do it with the <u>Strength</u> that God <u>Provides</u>. (1 Peter 4:11b)

- 1. We must always serve with total dependency on the Holy Spirit. (Zechariah 4:6)
- 2. As we serve God to bless others, He will Enable us with His grace.

(2 Corinthians 9:8)

7. In everything, do so that God may be glorified. (1 Peter 4:11c, 1 Corinthians 10:31)
