


Ezra 7:10

- 3. Share it with others confess testify

Psalm 100:1 - 5 (AMP) <sup>4</sup>Enter into His gates with thanksgiving and a thank offering and into His courts with praise! Be thankful and say so to Him, bless and affectionately praise His name! <sup>5</sup>For the Lord is good; His mercy and loving-kindness are everlasting, His faithfulness and truth endure to all generations.

Psalm 100:1 - 5 (NKJV) <sup>1</sup>Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! <sup>2</sup>Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing. <sup>3</sup>Know that the LORD, He is God; it is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture.
