the poor and the needy



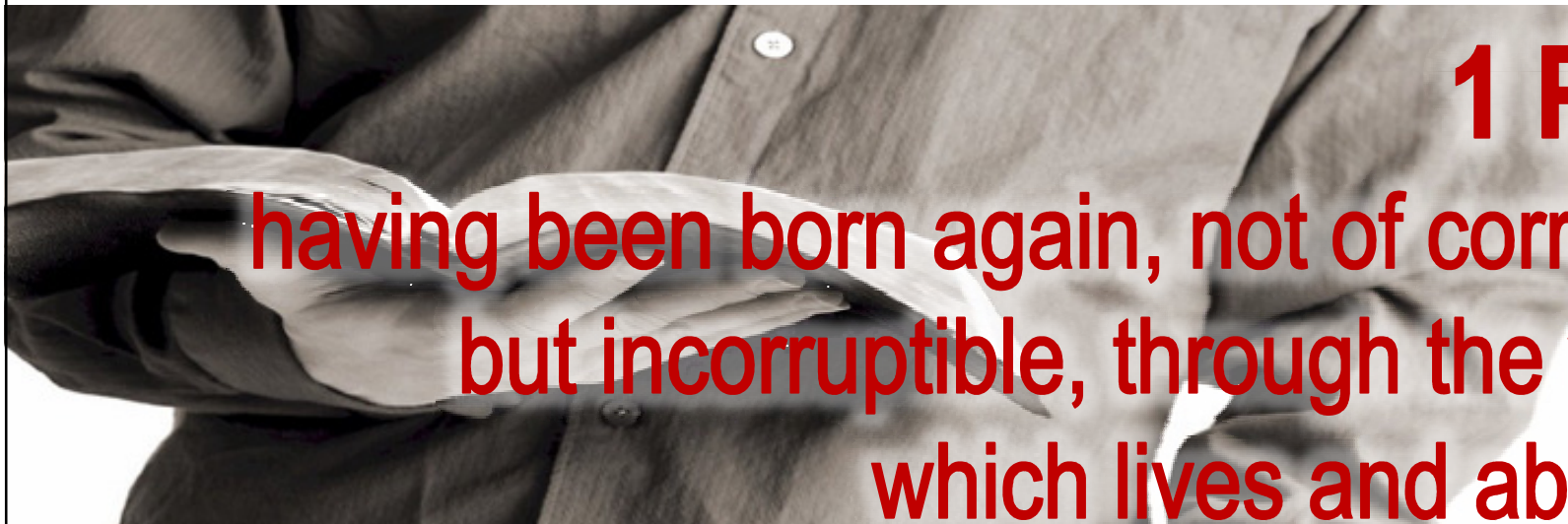

## Malachi 3:8

“Will a man rob God?

E. When we ask God to meet our needs,  
God will ask us for our seed [Matthew 6:33]

## Galatians 6:7

Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.







2. We must sow in Quality soil.

## Matthew 13:8

But others fell on good ground and yielded a crop: some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty.

The seed that is put in wrong soil nullify the harvest e.g. throwing the seed on the road or into the drain.





3. We must sow Proportionately with Expectation to receive.

## 2 Corinthians 9:6

But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

The farmer sows **proportionate seed** for the harvest he wants.





## Luke 16:10-12

**10** He who is faithful in what is least is faithful also in much; and he who is unjust in what is least is unjust also in much. **11** Therefore if you have not been faithful in the unrighteous mammon, who will commit to your trust the true riches? **12** And if you have not been faithful in what is another man's, who will give you what is your own?





A. We must sow our seed with expectation  
i.e. give our seed an assignment.

This is combining giving with prayer  
just as we combine fasting with prayer.

Centurion loved Israel and built  
a synagogue.

Cornelius gave generously to the needy  
and prayed to God regularly.



B. We must sow our seed with expectation  
i.e. give our seed an assignment.



Sow with purpose for a specific  
desire and result e.g.

**An Expectant Mother**





- buy baby clothes
- prepare the baby's room
- share the good news with friends
- find a name for the baby
- reading up on care and nutrition
- making baby care arrangements
- etc.

## **Matthew 7:11**

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask Him!





## **Matthew 7:7-8**

**7** “Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you.

**8** For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.





c. We must then receive to sow again.

- It is not enough simply to sow our seed.
- We must know how to receive our harvest.
- This is in order for you to sow again so that we will reap a perpetual harvest.
- This is to develop a posture of receiving and giving.





4. We must sow in Faith.

## Hebrews 11:6

But without faith it is impossible to please Him,  
for he who comes to God must believe that He is,  
and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently  
seek Him.





5. We must sow in the right **Season**.

**When** we sow is as important as what we sow.

Every Seed has a different  
germination period.

Every Seed has a different  
purpose or assignment.





In understanding **timing**,

it is vital to understand **moments**.

Every moment contains a different:

A. **Instruction**

i.e. an assignment that must be discerned.

B. **Benefit - Reward**



Whenever God orchestrate your divine moment in the right season, he will always connect you to a **person** *i.e. a man or woman sent by God who will unlock your faith and work with your covenant seed to break the chains of poverty, lack and financial bondage from your life.*

*Moses delivered Israel out of Egyptian  
bondage with wealth*





## Example #2

*Elijah sent to the starving  
widow of Zarephath*





## **Example #3**

*Elisha connected with the widow deeply  
in debt and he worked with her seed of oil  
to get out of debt*





## **Example #4**

*The woman with the issue of blood -  
seized her divine moment ..*

*Her faith made a demand on the anointing  
on Jesus and she was made whole.*





## **Example #5**

*Zacchaeus - Luke 15:3-5 ..*

*Seized the moment to cry out to the Lord  
Jesus and was saved*





## **Example #6**

*The young boy with 2 fishes and 5 loaves  
- seized the moment to give it all  
to the Lord Jesus who multiplied it  
to feed the 5000*

**John 10:10a**

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy.

Many never experience true financial freedom  
because they never learned to stand  
on God's Word.





6. We must look to the **LORD** of the Harvest.

➤ Anytime we decide to accept God at His Word, the enemy will attempt to:

i. **steal** the Word and prevent us from knowing God's Promises.

[seed on path snatched away by birds]

- **Matthew 13:19**

B. We must know that we have an **Enemy**.

➤ Anytime we decide to accept God at His Word, the enemy will attempt to:

ii. **prevent** the Word from taking root  
will trouble and persecution.

[seed on rocky places]

- **Matthew 13:20-21**





6. We must look to the **LORD** of the Harvest.

B. We must know that we have an **Enemy**.

➤ Anytime we decide to accept God at His Word, the enemy will attempt to:

iii. **choke** the Word

[thorns - worries of life and deceitfulness of wealth]

- Matthew 13:22





6. We must look to the **LORD** of the Harvest.

C. Standing on the Word means we must **Act / Apply / Obey / Do** the Word.

## **James 2:18**

But someone will say, “You have faith, and I have works.” Show me your faith without your works, and I will **show you my faith by my works.**





7. Waiting in constant prayer is the proof we believe God.

- After planting, many people go and dig up their seed pre-maturely.
- They do not realize that time must elapse before the harvest can come.

Harvest follows TIME.





We dig up the seed through:

- wrong words
- wrong attitudes
- we lower and change our expectations
- lose faith
- we nullify the planting of the seed
- we become double-minded





You know seed requires

- time to **germinate**
- time to **take root**
- time to **sprout**
- time to **ripen**
- then **harvest time**

Seed ... TIME ... Harvest Process

DO NOT FORGET TIME!!!!

The ability to wait is proof of your Faith.





- **First Sow**
- **Then Water** - Pray the Word
  - Stand on God's Promises  
as you wait for  
the Harvest!
