Sowing of Tithes,Offerings & Alms

Prayer

= Matthew 7:7-8

Hebrews 4:16

Prayer of Faith = Hebrews 11:6

- Earnestly = With expectancy of faith
- Earnestly = With something that cost you

Giving reflects your earnestness

Matthew 6:21: your treasure - your heart.

Combining Giving with Prayer of Faith On God's side, He hears our <u>prayers</u> and sees our <u>giving</u>.

Acts 10:31 (NCV)

... God has heard your prayer and has seen that you give to the poor and remembers you.

Combining Giving with Prayer of Faith On Man's side, we are to <u>intentionally</u> give and to <u>pray</u>.

Acts 10:2

a devout man and one who feared God with all his household, who gave alms generously to the people, and **prayed** to God always.

- We can give per se on its own
- We can pray per se on its own
- When combined intentionally in faith to God
 - = "Spiritual Synergy"

2 + 2 = 7

Q1: Is it wrong to give in order to receive?

A : No, if you combine it with Prayer of <u>Faith</u> and during the waiting period, continue to <u>water</u> the seed with <u>prayer</u> that stands on the <u>promise</u> - <u>Word of God</u>.

Luke 6:38

Give, and it will be given to you:

good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.

Q2: Is it wrong to give and pray for \$5m in your bank account & a BMW 7 series?

A: Not wrong, but just DAY DREAMING!

2 Cor 9:6 : Proportionate Seed

Hebrews 4:16: Needs, not wants

Our seed combined / watered with prayer for desired harvest for God to work on.

- e.g. 1 Elijah and Widow of Zarephath
- e.g. 2 Elisha and Widow with Debt

Ephesians 3:20 - Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us





Financial Freedom = Being "Rich"

- 3. We must sow <u>Proportionately</u> with <u>Expectation</u> to receive.

Seed Sowing

- 4. We must sow in Faith.
- 5. We must sow in the right **Season**.

- 1. Of all [100%] that God has given to us, He only ask His people to pay the Tithe. the Tithe belongs to the Lord.

- 1. Guard your heart from the Love of Money.
 - **A.** The love of money is serving **mammon**.

Matthew 6:24

"No one can serve two masters;

for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other.

You cannot serve God and mammon.

1 Timothy 6:17

Command those who are rich in this present age not to be **haughty**, nor to **trust in uncertain riches** but in the living God, who gives us richly all things to enjoy.

Deuteronomy 8:18



B. The love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.

1 Timothy 6:10

For the **love of money is a root of all kinds of evil**, for which some have strayed from the faith in their **greediness**, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.



c. The love of money is <u>covetousness</u> and <u>covetousness</u> is idolatry.

Colossians 3:5

Therefore put to death your members which are on the earth: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.

Hebrews 13:5a

Let your conduct be without covetousness;



D. The love of money is a temptation and **snare** leading to destruction.

1 Timothy 6:9

But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a **snare**, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition.

e.g. Margin Trading for "quick" gains - losses-death



E. The love of money will <u>choke</u> the seed of God's Word in your life.

Matthew 13:22

Now he who received seed among the thorns is he who hears the word, and the cares of this world and the deceitfulness of riches choke the word, and he becomes unfruitful.

Losing interest in spiritual things - backslide...



F. The love of money will wear you out.

Proverbs 23:4-5

4Do not overwork to be rich;

because of your own understanding, cease!

5Will you set your eyes on that which is not?

For riches certainly make themselves wings;

they fly away like an eagle toward heaven.

2. Determine your **Priority** of values with regards to money.

Matthew 6:24

"No one can serve two masters;

Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us **do good** to all, **especially** to those who are of the **household of faith**.



D. Then, according to our capacity, seek

 our path - Galatians 6:9-10

- 3. Know that some <u>Things / Values</u> are more important than money.
 - e.g. 1 Our **spiritual** life and growth.
 - e.g. 2 Building a strong marriage.
 - e.g. 3 Bringing up <u>children</u> in the fear and the knowledge of the Lord.
 - The mother who sacrifices her career to be a **homemaker**.

3. Know that some Things / Values are more important than money.



e.g. 4 - Work towards Financial Freedom:

- Downgrading to preserve disposable income to <u>reduce</u> financial burden on the household.
- Cut losses to stop the financial bleeding.
- Getting rid of the second house or the car and take public transport in order to <u>breathe</u> financially.

- 4. Determine your standard and level of life to live **Simply** to meet all your needs.
 - **A.** This is your **baseline** to live in godly contentment.

B. Anything above this baseline, **enjoy** and **abound**.

Philippians 4:12-13

12I know how to be **abased**, and I know how **to abound**. Everywhere and in all things I have learned both to **be full** and to be **hungry**, both to **abound** and to **suffer need**. **13**I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.





- 5. Know and understand the dynamics of **Borrowings / Debt**.
 - **A.** We live in a fallen world of Man's order of buying and selling, borrowing and lending.
 - B. Proverbs 22:7 the borrower is servant to the <u>lender</u>.

5. Know and understand the dynamics of **Borrowing / Debt**.



- c. Only borrow when you have income sources to more than meet the monthly repayments to the bank / financial institutions.
- D. Only borrow when your rate of return on your business and investments is <u>more</u> than the cost of borrowings.
- E. Wherever possible, review and get out of debt.

6. In all your monetary affairs, seek the Lord for Wisdom and Favour.

Psalm 5:12

For You, O LORD, will bless the **righteous**; with **favour** You will surround him as with a shield.

Psalm 84:11

James 1:5

If any of you lacks **wisdom**, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Proverbs 21:20

There is desirable treasure, and oil in the **dwelling** of the wise, but a foolish man squanders it.

- 7. As stewards, we are to be **Faithful** and **Wise**.
 - A. Matthew 24:45-51 We are to be end-times Faithful and Wise Servants of God.

Luke 16:10-12

Faithful in little ... also in much



- B. The wealth of the world is stored for the <u>righteous</u> *faithful and wise servant of God*.
 - ✓ This is not for every believer.
 - ✓ It is for the faithful and wise.
 - It is for those able to handle.
 - e.g. You don't give your car key to a 13 year old.



Proverbs 15:6

In the house of the righteous there is much treasure, but in the revenue of the wicked is trouble.

Faithfulness - Righteousness Right Standing and Right Doing-Living



- Never live <u>beyond</u> our means [MJ].
- Count our cost in every financial decision.
- Weigh risks and rewards always.
- Never <u>gamble</u> your money.



- Have a <u>budget</u> for capital and running expense.
- Never <u>eat</u> your seed. Sow them.
- Give and invest in your <u>heavenly account</u>.
 Philippians 4:17 Not that I seek the gift, but I seek the fruit that abounds to your account.



- Seek <u>value</u> purchases.
- Seek <u>quality</u> where needed.
- Make relevant and suitable investments.



- Think <u>twice</u> on that vacation / big ticket item.
- A \$ saved is a \$ income.
- Know difference between selfishness and self-care.



c. Wisdom has to be **sought**.

Proverbs 8:17

I love those who **love me [wisdom]**, and those who **seek** me diligently will find me.



D. Diligence is a mark of faithfulness.

Proverbs 10:4

He who has a slack hand becomes poor, but the hand of the **diligent** makes rich.

Proverbs 12:11

He who tills his land will be satisfied with bread,

but he who follows frivolity is devoid of understanding.





- 8. Our ultimate goal is never wealth by itself, it is **Ministry** to others.
 - > Wealth is just a **tool** for ministry.
 - > Wealth to **bless** others, be **generous**, **give**.
 - Blessed to bless others!
