

(a) Worship God **PASSIONATELY**

Mark 12:30

Love the Lord your God
with all your heart and
with all your soul and
with all your mind and
with all your strength.

The GOAL of the intake of the MILK of the Word is to EXPERIENCE the reality of the Promises of God / Word in your life .

Matthew 4:4

But He answered and said, "It is written,
'Man shall not live by bread alone,
but by every word that proceeds
from the mouth of God.'"

The **GOAL** of the intake of the **BREAD**
of the Word is to regularly hear
what the Lord is **SPEAKING** to you
in your daily living.

Hebrews 5:14

*But solid food belongs to those who are
of full age, that is, those who by reason
of use have their senses exercised
to discern both good and evil.*

The GOAL of the intake of the MEAT
of the Word is to sharpen
DISCERNMENT as you apply the Word
to the situations of your life.

a . Our Sinful Nature

- (ii) The remedy to our sinful nature is our Co-Crucifixion, Death And Resurrection In Christ.

If you keep your PURPOSE close at hand before you in your ministry.

Hebrews 12:1

i.e. HOLINESS

wheat into the barn;
but He will burn up the chaff
with unquenchable fire.

PURITY:

Holiness means Separation,
Sanctified, Set Apart

*There must be increase a sing separation
from :-*

- (a) The things that defile
- (b) The things that do not edify

And increase a sing separation to :-

The things of God, His Kingdom and His
Righteousness

V. Keep on being PLUGGED into
the BODY of Christ.

Psa lm 133:1 - 3

¹ Behold, how good and how pleasant it is
for brethren to dwell together in unity! ² It is
like the precious oil upon the head, running
down on the beard, the beard
of Aaron, running down on the edge of
his garments. ³ It is like the dew of Hermon,
descending upon the mountains of Zion;
for there the WORD commanded
the Blessing — life forevermore.
