A little girl wrote a letter to Dr James Dobson and said:



- Fo send away, to go away from, to release.
- "Forgiving is a commitment NOT to let our feelings of RESENTMENT come between us and those who have wronged us. It is RELEASING those feelings - SENDING them away." Letting them go!

Vicarious Anger


We divulge what that person did so that others will think less of them. That is an attempt to punish!
