1944 - Joseph Patrick Kennedy Jr. - killed in a plane explosion in England



1948 - Kathleen Kennedy - killed in a plane crash in France



1963 - Patrick Bouvier Kennedy died two days after his birth



1963 - U.S. President, John F. Kennedy assassinated in Dallas, Texas



1964 - U.S. Senator Ted Kennedy was involved in a plane crash in which the aide and the pilot were killed



1968 - U.S. Senator Robert F. Kennedy assassinated in Los Angeles



1969 - Ted Kennedy drove his car off a bridge and killed his passenger



1984 - David Kennedy died of a demerol and cocaine overdose in Florida



1997 - Michael Kennedy died in a skiing accident in Colorado



1999 - John F. Kennedy died of a plane crash. Wife and his sister-in-law were killed



2012 - Mary Richardson Kennedy hung herself on the grounds of her own home


