Max Jukes

Max Jukes

 - **310** who died as paupers;
 - **150** were criminals;
 - **7** were murderers;

 - **More than half** of
 the women were prostitutes.



Max Jukes
 His **540 descendants** cost the government
one and a quarter million dollars.
CURSES were the **primary inheritance**
of Max Juke's descendants.



Jonathan Edwards
Man of God, lived at about

 He married a godly woman and
 produced **at least 1394 descendants**
(that could be traced).

I. What is **Generational Iniquity**?

Exodus 20:4-6

You **shall not make** for yourself a carved image—any likeness of anything that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you **shall not bow** down to them nor serve them. For I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, visiting the **iniquity of the fathers** upon the children to the third and fourth generations of those who hate Me, but **showing mercy to thousands**, to those who love Me and keep My commandments.

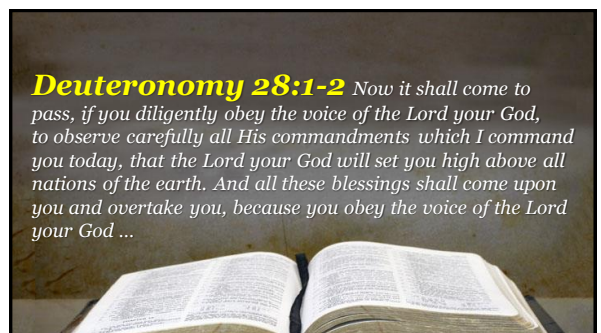
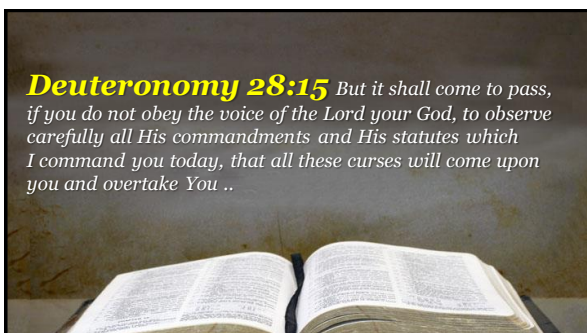
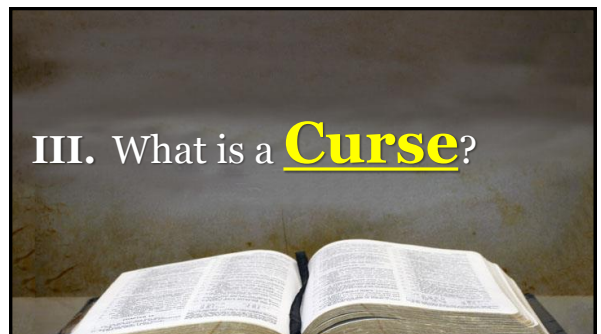
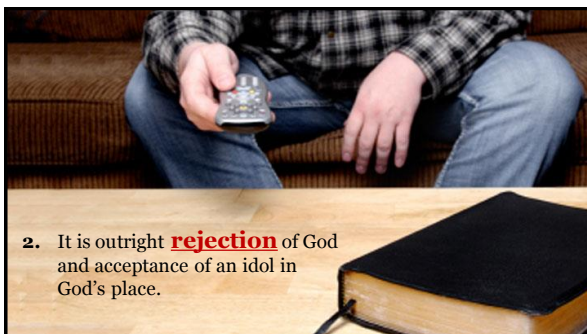
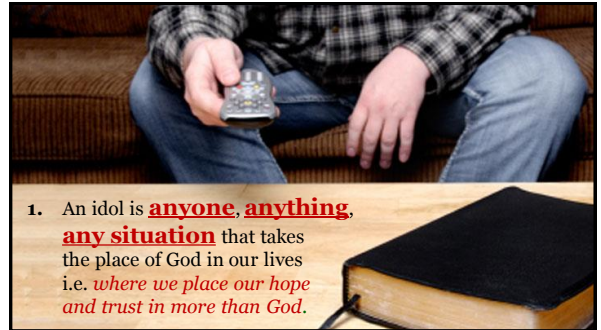
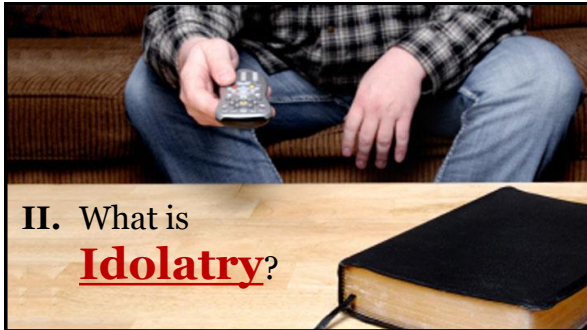
And the Lord passed before him and proclaimed, "The Lord, the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth, keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation."

Generational Iniquity is:

1. **Twistedness** because of the accumulated **sins** of our forefathers.
2. **Propensity** towards the **same negative** behavior traits.
3. **Pressure** to sin against the laws of God.

Generational Iniquity is:

4. Yet we are still **responsible** for our own sinful actions.
5. The idolatry-iniquity-curse cycle will continue until we **break** it by **repenting** before God.



Deuteronomy 30:19-20 *I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; therefore choose life, that both you and your descendants may live; that you may love the Lord your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."*

1. A curse is the opposite of a **blessing**.

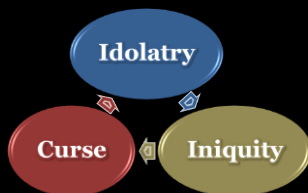

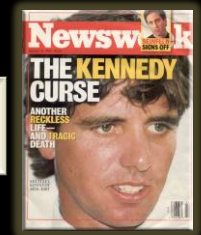

- killed in a plane crash in France



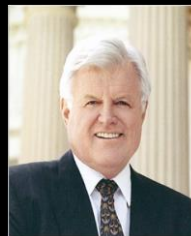
1963 - Patrick Bouvier Kennedy

assassinated in Dallas, Texas

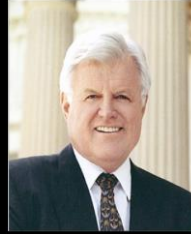


1964 - U.S. Senator Ted Kennedy


