Wessage Summary

Spiritual Objective: Understanding what generational iniquity is and how one can be set free from its bondage.

Restoring the Foundations (RTF) ministry is built around the need for an integrated approach to healing. Out of the four ministry areas, one of it is to reclaim the ground given to the devil due to the iniquity of our ancestors being visited down the family line – Generational iniquity.

I. What is Generational Iniquity? Exodus 20:4-6; 34:6-7

- Twistedness because of the accumulated sins of our forefathers.
- Propensity towards the same negative behaviour traits.
- Pressure to sin against the laws of God.
- Yet we are still responsible for our sinful actions.
- The Idolatry-Iniquity-Curse cycle will continue until we break it by repenting before God.

II. What is idolatry?

- An idol is anyone, anything, any situation that takes the place of God in our lives i.e.
 where we place our hope and trust in more than God
- It is outright rejection of God and acceptance of an idol in God's place.

III. What is a curse? Deuteronomy 28:15, 1-2; 30:19-20

- A curse is the opposite of a blessing
- A curse is the negative consequences of:
 - 1. Rejecting God
 - 2. Reaping the harvest of specific sins that have been sown
 - 3. The destructive works of the evil one through a foothold- Doorway that is opened.

IV. How to walk in freedom and victory?

- 1A. Confess our sings and our ancestors' sins.
- 1B. Ask for God's forgiveness (Leviticus 26:40 Daniel 9:4-20)
- 2A. Forgive and release all who caused you to sin and to suffer the effects of their sins.
- 2B. Forgive yourself.
- 3. Renounce and break the power of the curses.
- 4. Appropriate personally the freedom and blessings that Christ purchased for us. Galatians 3:13-14
