

 From Consequences of Generational Iniquity. 	RTF= SOFC - Sins of the fathers and resulting curses
2. From Lies and Deception.	RTF = UGB - Ungodly Beliefs
 From Inner Hurts and Wounds in our soul. 	RTF = <mark>SSH</mark> - Soul-Spirit Hurts
4. From Demonic Harassment.	RTF = DO - Demonic Oppression









- Exercise: Steps to healing our inner hurts and wounds.
- **1.** <u>Express</u> the hurt, frustrations, and pain to the Lord.
- 2. Invite the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to reveal the <u>source</u> of the hurts ...
- 3. <u>Invite</u> the Lord Jesus into the memory to bring <u>healing</u> and <u>truth</u>.

Exercise: Steps to healing our inner hurts and wounds.

- 4. <u>Break</u> any agreement with each <u>UGB</u> attached to this hurt.
- 5A. Apply the <u>Blood</u> of Christ to the hurts / wounds.
- **5B.** Invite the <u>Holy Spirit</u> (oil) to soothe and heal the pain.
- **5C.** Ask <u>Father-God</u> to bind up and heal completely the pain-hurt.
- 6. Thank the Lord for healing the inner hurts and wounds.



I. As children of God, we have divine protection.

1 John 5:18 We know that whoever is born of God does not sin; but he who has been born of God keeps himself, and the wicked one does not touch / harm (*NIV*) him.

I. As children of God, we have divine protection.

Exodus 12:22-23 And you shall take a bunch of hyssop, dip it in the blood that is in the basin, and strike the lintel and the two <u>doorposts</u> <u>with the blood</u> that is in the basin. And none of you shall go out of the door of his house until morning. For the Lord will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the <u>blood on the lintel and</u> <u>on the two doorposts</u>, the Lord will pass over the door and <u>not allow</u> the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you. The devil cannot harass us unless we give him <u>ground-foothold-doorway</u> to our lives, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

Ephesians 4:26-27 (NIV) 'In your anger do not sin': do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil

a foothold.

Judges 1:21 But the <u>children of Benjamin did not drive out</u> the Jebusites who inhabited Jerusalem; so the Jebusites dwell with the children of Benjamin in Jerusalem to this day.

Judges 1:27 However, <u>Manasseh</u> did not drive out the inhabitants of Beth Shean and its villages ...

II. The devil cannot harass us unless we give him groundfoothold-doorway to our lives, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

Judges 1:29-31 <u>Nor did Ephraim</u> drive out the Canaanites who dwelt in Gezer ... Nor did <u>Zebulun</u> drive out the inhabitants of Kitron or the inhabitants of Nahalol ... <u>Nor did Asher</u> drive out the inhabitants of Acco or ...

Judges 1:33 Nor did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Beth Shemesh or the inhabitants of Beth Anath ... II. The devil cannot harass us unless we give him groundfoothold-doorway to our lives, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

Numbers 33:55 But if you do not drive out the inhabitants of the land from before you, then it shall be that those whom you let remain shall be **irritants** in your eyes and **thorns** in your sides,

and they shall harass you in the land where you dwell.

1. Possible <u>Ground-Foothold-Doorway</u> D. Habitual <u>Sins</u>

Galatians 5:19-21 Now the <u>works of the flesh</u> are evident, which are: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries, and the like; of which I tell you beforehand, just as I also told you in time past, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

1. Possible <u>Ground-Foothold-Doorway</u> E. Bitterness

Hebrews 12:15 (NIV) See to it that no one <u>falls short of the grace of</u> <u>God</u> and that no <u>bitter root</u> grows up to cause <u>trouble</u> and <u>defile</u> many.

F. Involvement with the occult.

Joshua 7:11-12 Israel has <u>sinned</u>, and they have also transgressed My covenant which I commanded them. For they have even <u>taken</u> <u>some of the accursed things</u>, and have both stolen and deceived; and they have also put it among their own stuff. <u>Therefore</u> the children of Israel <u>could not stand before their enemies</u>, but turned their backs before their enemies, because they have become doomed to destruction. <u>Neither will I be with you anymore, unless you **destroy**</u>

the accursed from among you.

F. Involvement with the occult.

Deuteronomy 7:24-25 ... no one shall be able to stand against you until you have destroyed them. You shall <u>burn the Carved images</u> of their gods with fire; you shall <u>not covet the silver or</u> gold that is on them, nor take it for yourselves, <u>lest you be Snared</u> by it; for <u>it is an abomination</u> to the Lord your God.

1. Possible Ground-Foothold-Doorway

G. <u>Trauma</u> - Accidents, Abuse, etc.

TRAUMA = Open Doors to spirits of Fear, Shame & Control e.g. 1 - trapped in a lift

e.g. 2 - bitten by a dog

- e.g. 3 near drowning experience
- e.g. 4 abuse

Examples of Demonic Harassment: A. <u>Physically</u> Luke 7:21 And that your hour. He away of inform

Luke 7:21 And that very hour, He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits, and to many blind, He gave sight.

2. Examples of Demonic Harassment: **B.** Mentally

Luke 8:35 Then they went out to see what had happened, and came to Jesus, and found the man from whom the demons had departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid.

Luke 8:26-39

2. Examples of Demonic Harassment: C. Emotionally Excessive Stress Excessive Anxieties Excessive Fears

2. <u>Examples</u> of Demonic Harassment: D. Spiritually

Matthew 12:43 When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none.

- i. When there is significant spiritual change and growth in our lives.
- ii. When there is significant change in spiritual activities.

III. Understand about "Dry Places" vs "Streams of Living Waters".

Matthew 12:43-45 When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first. So shall it also be with this wicked generation."

III. Understand about "Dry Places" vs "Streams of Living Waters".

Exodus 15:26-27 and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the Lord who heals you (Jehovah Rapha)." Then they came to Elim, where there were twelve wells of water and seventy palm trees; so they camped there by the waters.

III. Understand about "Dry Places" vs "Streams of Living Waters".

John 7:37-39 On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Holy Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

IV. Know our Spiritual Authority.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give you the <u>authority to trample</u> on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and <u>nothing</u> shall by any means <u>hurt you</u>. **IV.** Know our Spiritual <u>Authority</u>.

James 4:6-7 But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

V. Know our Spiritual <u>Weapons</u>.
1. The <u>Name</u> of the Lord Jesus

Mark 16:17 And these signs will follow <u>those who believe</u>: <u>In</u> <u>My name they will cast out demons</u>; they will speak with new tongues ... V. Know our Spiritual <u>Weapons</u>.
2. The <u>Blood</u> of the Lamb

Revelation 12:11 And they <u>overcame him by the blood of</u> <u>the Lamb</u> and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.

V. Know our Spiritual <u>Weapons</u>.
3. The <u>Sword</u> of the Spirit

Ephesians 6:17 (NIV) Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

- VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one. Do this knowing:
 - your spiritual <u>authority</u> and <u>power</u>.
 - your divine protection.

VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 1A. <u>Confess</u> your sins and <u>repent</u> for giving <u>ground</u>

to the demons of ...

Ask God for <u>forgiveness</u>.

1 John 1:9 If we <u>confess</u> our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 1C. Forgive <u>all</u> who influenced you to sin.

1D. Forgive <u>yourself</u>.

1 John **1:9** If we <u>confess</u> our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 2. Appropriate the <u>Blood</u> of Christ to:

- A. <u>cleanse</u> your spirit and body.
- **B.** <u>cover</u> the ground previously given.

2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us <u>cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of</u> the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God. VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 <u>Renounce</u> and <u>break</u> all agreements with demonic strongholds of including associated demons of

Ephesians 4:27 nor give place / ground to the devil.

VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 4. In the Name of Jesus, <u>command</u> this demonic

stronghold and all associated demons to leave you.

James 4:7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

 VI. <u>Steps</u> to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one.
 5. Pray for a fresh infilling of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> into all the newly cleared out areas in your life.

Ephesians 5:18 And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit ...

- 6. <u>Cleanse</u> and <u>sanctify</u> by the blood of Jesus:
 - A. everyone involved.
 - B. the place.
- 7. Invite the light of the <u>Presence</u> of God to come in.
- 8. Daily <u>walk out</u> the victory we already have.
