Message Summary

Spiritual Objective: Understanding how to be free from demonic harassment

1. As Children of God, we have divine protection.

- 1 John 5:18. Evil cannot harm or touch us.

2. The devil cannot harass us unless we give him Ground-Foothold-Doorway to our lives, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

The Israelites in Judges 1:21 and Numbers 33:55 did not drive away the previous inhabitants of the land, and they later became harassment to the Israelites.

- Possible Ground-Foothold-Doorways:

A. Consequences of Generational Iniquity - SOFC

B. Lies and Deceptions – UGBs

C. Hurts and Wounds – SSHs

D. Habitual Sin (Galatians 5:19-21)

E. Bitterness (Hebrews 12:15)

The fruit of bitterness is resentment, offenses, relational conflicts and quarrels.

F. Involvement with the Occult (Galatians 5:19-21)

e.g. temple visits, dedications to other gods/idols in the past ... We are told in Joshua 7:11-12 and Deuteronomy 7:24-25 to take these accursed things and burn them with fire.

G. Trauma – Accidents, Abuse, etc. (Matthew 12:43)

e.g. being trapped in a lift, bitten by a dog, near drowning experience ... These incidents open doors to spirits of fear, shame and control.

- Examples of Demonic Harassment:

A. Physically (Luke 7:21)

e.g. photos of occult objects, items bought from overseas

B. Mentally (Luke 8:35)

C. Emotionally

e.g. excessive stress, anxieties, fears

D. Spiritually

I. When there is significant change and growth in our lives.

II. When there is significant change in spiritual activities.

3. Understand about “Dry Places” vs “Streams of Living Water”.

- Matthew 12:43-45

- John 7:37-39

Living waters – we are to dwell in the wet places. E.g. Elim (Exodus 15:27). It is important to be conscious of and connected to the Holy Spirit.

4. Know our Spiritual Authority.

- Luke 10: 19

We have the authority to trample and stamp on serpents and scorpions with our feet!

- James 4:6-7

5. Know your Spiritual Weapons.

- The Name of the Lord Jesus (Mark 16:17)

- The Blood of the Lamb (Revelation 12:11)

- The Sword of the Spirit (Ephesians 6:17)

Use our will to resist and command the devil to go!

6. Steps to overcome demonic harassment by the evil one

- Confess your sins and repent for giving ground to the demons of ...

- Ask God for forgiveness

- Forgive all who influenced you to sin

- Forgive yourself

- Appropriate the blood of Christ to:

A. Cleanse your spirit and body

B. Clear the ground previously given (2 Corinthians 7:1)

- Renounce and break all agreements with demonic stronghold of ... including associated demons of ... (Ephesians 4:27)

- In the Name of Jesus, command this demonic stronghold and all associated demons to leave you. (James 4:7)

- Pray for a fresh infilling of the Holy Spirit into all the newly cleared out areas in your life. (Ephesians 5:18)

- Cleanse and sanctify by the blood of Jesus

A. Everyone involved

B. The place

- Invite the light of the presence of God to come in

- Daily walk out the victory we already have
