# NO Condemnation in our Eternal Destiny.

Romans 8:1 Therefore, there is now <u>no condemnation</u> for <u>those</u> who are <u>in Christ Jesus</u> ...

### **Condemnation =**

- to express strong disapproval of; censure
- to pronounce judicial sentence on
- to demonstrate the guilt of
- to judge or pronounce unfit for use
- to compel or force into a particular state or activity

### = adverse sentence against the person

### I. NO Condemnation in Our Eternal **Destiny**.

Revelations 20:10 The devil, who deceived them,
was cast into the <u>lake of fire</u> and brimstone
where the beast and the false prophet are.
And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.
14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire.
This is the second death. 15 And anyone not found written
in the Book of Life was cast into the <u>lake of fire</u>.

- I. NO Condemnation in Our Eternal **Destiny**.
  - > The believer in Christ is forever justified.
  - > We are saved from the **penalty** of our sins.

Romans 6:23 For the <u>Wages of sin is death</u>, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord. I. NO Condemnation in Our Eternal **Destiny**.

1 Corinthians 1:30 (NIV) It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our <u>righteousness</u>, <u>holiness</u> and <u>redemption</u>.

Righteousness - Justified- Saved from penalty of sinHoliness- Sanctified- Saved from power of sinRedemption- Glorified- Saved from presence of sin

NO Condemnation for the believer in Christ means:

- = God's Justification of us
- = God's Gift of Grace to us
- = God's Gift of Righteousness
- = God's Gift of Eternal Life

## This position <u>cannot</u> be reversed.

No angel nor man, nothing in all creation including our sins can reverse it.

Romans 8:32 He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? 33 Who shall bring a **charge** against God's elect? It is God who justifies. 34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us. 35 Who shall **separate** us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

- 2 classes of people enter eternity:
- Those who are in <u>Adam</u> (Unbelievers)
- 2. Those who are in <u>Christ</u> (Believers)

### II. NO Condemnation in Our Present Living.

Romans 8:1 (NKJV) There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> to those who are <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, who do not <u>walk</u> according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit.

Romans 8:1 (AMP) Therefore, [there is] now <u>no condemnation</u> (no adjudging guilty of wrong) for those who are <u>in Christ Jesus</u>, who <u>live [and] walk</u> not after the dictates of the flesh, but after the dictates of the Spirit. II. NO Condemnation in Our Present Living.

A. This will **NOT** be the experience of those who walk-live according to the **flesh**.

- 1. Those who live according to the <u>flesh</u> are those who live their lives:
  - i. Independent of God.
  - ii. Not under the authority of <u>scriptures</u>.
  - iii. Not yielded to the prompting and guidance of the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.

- 1. Those who live according to the **flesh** are those who live their lives:
  - iv. Following the ways of the world.
  - v. Relying on the opinions of man.
  - vi. Yielding to the lies and deceptions of the evil one.

2. Those who live in the flesh are vulnerable to the devil <u>accusing</u> them.

Revelation 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them <u>before our God</u> day and night, has been cast down.

# Accusing us before God - before Christ's death and resurrection.

- i. The story of <u>Job</u>.
- Job 1:6-12
- possibly ground given in lives of his children and himself.
- burnt offerings = <u>blood</u> covering = hedge of protection
- satan had <u>access</u> to God

ii. The story of **Joshua**, the High Priest.

Zechariah 3:1 Then he showed me Joshua the high priest standing before the Angel of the LORD, and Satan standing at his right hand to oppose him. 2 And the LORD said to Satan, "The LORD rebuke you, Satan! The LORD who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you! Is this not a brand plucked from the fire?"
3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and was standing before the Angel.

### ii. The story of **Joshua**, the High Priest.

Zechariah 3:4 Then He answered and spoke to those who stood before Him, saying, "Take away the filthy garments from him." And to him He said, "See, I have removed your iniquity from you, and I will clothe you with rich robes." 5 And I said, "Let them put a clean turban on is head." So they put a clean turban on his head, and they put the clothes on him. And the Angel of the LORD stood by.

#### iii. The story of <u>Peter</u>.

Luke 22:31 And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. 32 But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren." 2. Those who live in the flesh are vulnerable to the devil **accusing** them.

Revelation 12:10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, "Now salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of His Christ have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.

Accusing us directly - after Christ's death and resurrection.

- 2. Those who live in the flesh are vulnerable to the devil **accusing** them.
- John 12:31 Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be <u>cast out</u>.

- 3. Continual Guilt and Condemnation leads to:
  - i. discouragement [fear consequences, shame]
  - ii. doubts
  - iii. despondency [isolation, rejection]

- 3. Continual Guilt and Condemnation leads to:
  - iv. depression [feeling worthless, lowered esteem]
  - v. <u>death</u>

 John 3:20 For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.
 Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God.

- II. NO Condemnation in Our Present Living.
  - B. This <u>WILL BE</u> the experience of those who walk-live according to the <u>spirit</u>.

1. Those who walk-live according to the <u>spirit</u> know that we have the Gift of <u>Righteousness</u> in Christ Jesus.

Romans 5:17b ... much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the **gift of righteousness** will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ.

Righteousness is through faith in Christ

Romans 10:10 - with the heart, man believe unto Righteousness

This gift of Righteousness is the Righteousness of God.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

I am the Righteousness of God in Christ Jesus

 Those who live according to the spirit know that we have right <u>standing</u> with God.
 This gives us <u>boldness</u> and <u>confidence</u> to <u>always</u> come into the Presence of God.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come **boldly** to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Hebrews 10:19 Therefore, brethren, having **boldness** to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

 Those who live according to the spirit know that we have right <u>standing</u> with God.
 This gives us <u>boldness</u> and <u>confidence</u> to <u>always</u> come into the Presence of God.

1 Timothy 1:19 having <u>faith</u> and a <u>good conscience</u>, which some having rejected, concerning the faith have suffered shipwreck  Those who live according to the spirit know that we have right <u>standing</u> with God.
 This gives us <u>boldness</u> and <u>confidence</u> to <u>always</u> come into the Presence of God.

Romans 1:17 For in it the <u>righteousness of God</u> is revealed from <u>faith to faith</u>; as it is written, "The just shall live by faith."

3. Those who live according to the spirit know that we can **resist** the evil one.

James 4:6 But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble." 7 Therefore submit to God. **Resist the devil** and he will flee from you. 3. Those who live according to the spirit know that we can **resist** the evil one.

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary <u>the devil</u> walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour. 9 <u>Resist him</u>, steadfast in the faith ... 3. Those who live according to the spirit know that we can **resist** the evil one.

Revelations 12:11 And they <u>overcame him</u> by the blood of the Lamb and by the <u>word of</u> their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
















4. Those who live according to the spirit do **NOT** seek their **own** righteousness.

**Philippians 3:9** 

and be found in Him, <u>not having my own</u> <u>righteousness</u>, which is <u>from the law</u>, <u>but that</u> which is through <u>faith in Christ</u>, the <u>righteousness which is from God by faith</u>.

## **Journey in Brokenness**

## This is also the application of the Law of **Spirit of Life** over the law of sin and death.



Do NOT seek your own righteousness. The evil one always attacks us with the law. i.e. What we must do or fail to do; condemn us and give us guilt whenever he accuses us.

2 Corinthians 3:6 ... for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

- Those who live according to the spirit know that our right standing with God does not <u>exempt</u> us from the laws in life to relate well with people and live right.
- Galatians 6:7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked;
  for whatever a man <u>SOWS</u>, that he <u>will also reap</u>.
  8 For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption,
  but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.
