Different views about the timing of rapture:

- > They are all partly true.
- Many assume one rapture.
- But, there are a total of <u>7 Raptures</u> mentioned in Scriptures.

Different phrases used in the Scriptures: John 14:3 - received unto the Lord.

1 Thessalonians 4:16 - caught up to meet the Lord in the air.

[Gk-Harpazo - seize - catch - pluck - take by force]

2 Thessalonians 2:1 - gathered together





The Third Rapture THE LORD JESUS CHRIST

(Preceded by His Resurrection)

Acts 1:9 Now when He had spoken these things, while they watched, He was <u>taken up</u>, and a cloud received Him out of their sight.

THE RAPTURE OF THE SAINTS

1 Corinthians 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

THE RAPTURE OF THE SAINTS

 Thessalonians 4:16-17
 For the Lord Himself will descend from heaven with a <u>shout</u>, with the <u>voice of an archangel</u>, and with the <u>trumpet of God</u>. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
 Then we who are alive and remain shall be <u>caught up</u> together with them <u>in the clouds to meet the Lord</u> <u>in the air</u>. And thus we shall always be with the Lord.

Description of this company: They are the <u>crystal sea</u> company.

Revelation 4:6 Before the throne there was a <u>sea</u> <u>of glass</u>, <u>like crystal</u>. And in the midst of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes in front and in back.

Description of this company: They have <u>Robes</u> of <u>Righteousness</u>. They <u>sing</u> the <u>new song</u> [Revelation 5:9].

- They will <u>reign</u> with <u>Christ</u> on the earth [Revelation 5:10].

- This is the reward of the over-comers, of the faithful and wise servants of God.

Revelation 19:7-8 (NIV)

7 Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the <u>wedding of the Lamb has come</u>, and <u>his bride has made herself ready</u>. 8 *Fine linen*, *bright and clean*, was given her to wear."

(Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of God's holy people.)

The Fifth Rapture THE MID-TRIBULATION RAPTURE (This rapture is in the middle of the 7-year Tribulation Period mentioned in Revelation 7:9-17)



Revelation 7:9 After these things I looked, and behold, <u>a great multitude</u> which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, <u>standing before the throne and before</u> <u>the Lamb</u>, clothed with <u>white robes</u>, with palm branches in their hands

Revelation 7:13-14

13 Then one of the elders answered, saying to me, "Who are these arrayed in white robes, and where did they come from?" 14 And I said to him, "Sir, you know." So he said to me, "These are the ones who come out of the great tribulation, and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

This Mid-Tribulation Rapture is different from the earlier Rapture of the Righteous Dead:

- A. It does *NOT* have the accompanying resurrection mentioned in 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17.
- mentioned in 1 Thessalonians 4.16-17.
- B. The Lord Jesus did **NOT** meet them in the air.
- C. They did not sing the new song **BUT** only the song of Moses and the Lamb.

This Mid-Tribulation Rapture is different from the earlier Rapture of the Righteous Dead:

- **D.** They were snatched from the earth to escape the wrath of the devil.
 - At Mid-Tribulation, the Anti-Christ breaks the Covenant with Israel.
- E. They washed their robes in the Blood of the Lamb [Revelation 7:14; 1 John 1:9].

Revelation 3:4 You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with Me in white, for they are worthy.











Revelation 14:1-5

3 They <u>sang</u> as it were <u>a new song</u> before the throne, before the four living creatures, and the elders; and <u>no one could learn that song except the hundred and</u> <u>forty-four thousand</u> who were redeemed from the earth.





from among men, being first fruits to God and to the Lamb. 5 And in their mouth was found <u>NO</u> deceit, for they are without fault before the throne of God.





The Rapture of the 2 Witnesses

Revelation 11:3 And I will give power to my two witnesses, and they will prophesy one thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth."



Revelation 11:5 And if anyone wants to harm them, <u>fire proceeds from their mouth</u> and devours their enemies. And if anyone wants to harm them, he must be killed in this manner.



Revelation 11:6 These <u>have power to shut</u> <u>heaven</u>, so that no rain falls in the days of their prophecy; and they have <u>power over waters</u> to turn them to blood, and <u>to strike the earth with</u> <u>all plagues</u>, as often as they desire.





The Rapture of the 2 Witnesses

Revelation 11:9 Then those from the peoples, tribes, tongues, and <u>nations will see their dead</u> <u>bodies three-and-a-half days</u>, and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves.

The Rapture of the 2 Witnesses

Revelation 11:10 And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.

The Rapture of the **2 Witnesses**

Revelation 11:11 Now <u>after</u> the three-and-a-half days the <u>breath of life from God entered them</u>, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them.

2 Corinthians 5:10-11

10 For we must <u>all appear before the judgment seat</u> of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, <u>whether good</u> or <u>bad</u>. 11 Knowing, therefore, the <u>terror of the Lord</u>, we <u>persuade men</u>; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are <u>well known in your consciences</u>.

Matthew 25:21, 23
