Do not get entangled with label!

Clarify - Define -Let Scriptures Speak for itself!



- 1. We are saved by **grace** through **faith** and we have eternal life forever.
- We are saved to do good works.
   Our good works will determine the rewards or losses both now in this life as well as that which is to come.
- 3. If we, who have been enlightened, tasted the goodness and the power of God, turn <u>against</u> God i.e. become <u>apostate</u>, we will <u>lose</u> our salvation.

Being understanding parents


Cooking a meal

Hebrews 6:4-6

4For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, 5and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, 6if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame.

### 2 Peter 2:20-22

20For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. 21For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. 22But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: "A dog returns to his own vomit," and, "a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire."

26For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,

27but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries.

# Hebrews 10:29-31 29Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? 30For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine, I will repay," says the Lord. And again, "The LORD will judge His people." 31<u>It is a fearful thing to fall into</u> the hands of the living God.


e.g. 2 - Nadab, Abihu
