Warnings against Lukewarmness

Revelation 3:14-15

14And to the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write, "These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God:
15"I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot. I could wish you were cold or hot.

Revelation 3:16-17

16So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.
17Because you say, "I am rich, have become wealthy, and have need of nothing" - and do not know that you are wretched, miserable, poor, blind, and naked ~

Revelation 3:18

Three Applications

Buy <u>Gold</u> refined in the fire. (a) This is <u>genuine tested personal</u> <u>faith</u> of an overcomer.



1 Peter 1:6-7

6 In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various trials, 7that the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes. though it is tested by fire, may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ.

John 16:33

i. In the world, there are **Trials** affecting <u>ALL</u>. ii. For believers, our faith will be <u>tested</u>.

(b) We are to **Buy** this Gold refined in the fire.

"Buy" suggests that it will cost us i.e. this is Work. EffortPersecutionEnergy Money CostSacrificeSufferingCriticismDeath to ourTimePainold man

(c) We can **Overcome** the trials in the world.

1 Corinthians 10:13

No temptation / trial has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.

(d) Our Faith in God overcome these trials.

- 1 John 5:4-5
- 4for everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world, even our faith.
- 5Who is it that overcomes the world?
- Only he who **believes** that Jesus is the Son of God.



(e) The <u>Gold</u> is the outcome - reward of our Work of Faith.

1 Corinthians 3:12-14

12Now if anyone builds on this foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw,

(e) The <u>Gold</u> is the outcome - reward of our Work of Faith.

1 Corinthians 3:12-14

13each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, because it will be revealed by fire; and the fire will test each one's work, of what sort it is. 14lf anyone's work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.

(a) The <u>Gold</u> is the reward of our Work of Faith.

- \checkmark This is our growing faith.
- ✓ This is our growing unto spiritual maturity.
- This is Christ increasing and "I, me and myself" decreasing.
- This is where my response is increasingly unto the Lord.

- A few did not defile their garments ...
- They walk in white ...
- He who **overcomes** shall be clothed in white garments ...

Revelation 19:7-8

the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His Bride has made herself ready. Fine linen, bright and clean

was given her to wear. *(Fine linen stands for the Righteous Acts of the saints)*

Hebrews 1:9 You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness/wickedness

Buy WHITE GARMENTS mean

- We pay the price to walk
 - ✓ in righteousness
 - \checkmark in holiness
 - separation from
 - separation to godliness

Buy WHITE GARMENTS mean

- We pay the price to walk in holiness
 - what is permissible for <u>others</u> may not be permissible for you.
 - what <u>was</u> permissible may not be permissible now as you grow spiritually.

Buy WHITE GARMENTS mean

- We pay the price to be blameless
 - To have a conscience void of offense before God and man [Acts 24:16].
 - To have integrity wholeness
 [1 Thessalonians 5:23].

Luke 11:34-35

34The lamp of the body is the eye. Therefore when your eye is good, your whole body also is full of light. But when your eye is bad, your body also is full of darkness. 35Therefore take heed that the light which is in you is not darkness.

This is **Spiritual Seeing**. This is **Wisdom** and **Revelation**.

This means we have:-

- Knowledge Oversight
- Understanding Insight
- Wisdom Foresight

A. From the Intake of the Word.

Psalm 19:8

"... The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes ..."

Colossians 3:16 Be filled with the Word of God

1 Peter 2:2-3

2as newborn babes, desire the pure **milk of the Word**, that you may grow thereby, 3if indeed you have **tasted** that the Lord is gracious.



The <u>Goal</u> of the intake of the <u>Milk</u> of the Word is to <u>Experience</u> the reality of the Promises of God / Word in your life.

Matthew 4:4

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by **bread** alone, but by **every word that proceeds from the mouth of God**."



The **Goal** of the intake of the **Bread** of the Word is to regularly hear what the Lord is **Speaking** to you in your daily living.

Hebrews 5:14

But solid food belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.



The <u>Goal</u> of the intake of the <u>Meat</u> of the Word is to sharpen <u>Discernment</u> as you apply the Word to the situations of your life.

B. From your <u>Connectivity</u> with the Holy Spirit.

Ephesians 1:17-18

"... the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation ... that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened"

B. From your <u>Connectivity</u> with the Holy Spirit.

1 Thessalonians 5:19 (NIV) Do not put out the Spirit's fire

Ephesians 5:18 Be filled with the Spirit of God

B. From your <u>Connectivity</u> with the Holy Spirit.

1 Corinthians 2:9-10 (NIV)
9"No eye has seen, no ear has heard, no mind has conceived what God has prepared for those who love Him" 10but God has revealed it to us by His Spirit.
