Numbers 6:24-26 (NIV)

24The LORD **bless you** and keep you; **25**the LORD make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you; **26**the LORD turn his face toward you and give you **peace**.

First Revelation of Jehovah Shalom:

1Then the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD. So the LORD delivered them into the hand of Midian for seven years, **2**and the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel. Because of the Midianites, the children of Israel made for themselves the dens, the caves, and the strongholds which are in the mountains.

Fear of the Future	Feeling of Inadequacy
Unable to meet parents' or teachers' or bosses' expectations	
Distracted by many things - friends, parties, gaming, etc	Fear of being left out in life
