


1. We are living in times of increasing lawlessness.

2 speaking lies in hypocrisy, having their own conscience seared with a hot iron ...






1. We are living in times of increasing **lawlessness**.

2 Timothy 3:1-5

1 But know this, that **in the last days perilous times** will come: 2 For men will be **lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful,** unholy, 3 unloving, **unforgiving,** slanderers, **without self-control, brutal,** despisers of good, 4 traitors, headstrong, haughty, **lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,** 5 having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!


2 Peter 1:4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the

Nevertheless, **when the Son of Man comes**, **will He really find faith on the earth?"**




3. Many will **abandon** their faith in God.

1 John 5:4-5

4. Many will **dis-connect** from the love of God.

Revelation 2:4 Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have **left your first love**.

Matthew 24:12b ... the **love [agape]**
of many will grow cold.

1 John 4:10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

2. We begin our relationship with God by believing and receiving Christ Jesus into our lives.

Romans 10:9-10

9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.



3. Thereafter, we continue our relationship with God by **connecting** with Him continually.

2 Corinthians 13:14 The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and **the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all.** Amen.

A. Intake of His **Word**.


B. **Prayer** Communion.

- 6C. Pursue a guilt-free, no-condemnation relationship with God.




7. We can always connect with Him:

- B. through Jesus our High Priest.




Hebrews 10:19-22


8. Hence, we are exhorted to pray without ceasing.

1 Thessalonians 5:17 pray without ceasing ...




9. When we do not connect with God in prayer, things in our lives will revert to the **natural** laws of life.



Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?


