4. Continue with **Praise**.

Psalm 34:1 I will bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalm 138:1-2

 I will praise You with my whole heart; before the gods I will sing praises to You.
 I will worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified / Your word above all Your name.



Psalm 103:1-5

 Bless the Lord, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name!
 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and <u>forget not all His</u> <u>benefits</u>:
 Who <u>forgives</u> all your iniquities, Who <u>heals</u> all your diseases,
 Who <u>needeems</u> your life from destruction, Who <u>crowns</u> you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,
 Who <u>satisfies</u> your mouth with good things, so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.



Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us <u>continually offer the sacrifice of praise</u> to God, that is, the <u>fruit of our lips</u>, <u>giving</u> <u>thanks/confessing to His name</u>.

Names - Attributes -Character of Father-God, Lord Jesus and Holy Spirit



5. Worship in surrender.

Romans 12:1-2

1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you **present your bodies** <u>a living sacrifice</u>, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. 2 And <u>do not be</u> <u>conformed to this world</u>, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may <u>prove</u> what is that <u>good and acceptable and perfect</u> <u>will of God</u>.



6. When we pray and connect with God, always do so with your <u>whole</u> heart, soul, strength and mind.

Romans 8:26-28

26 Likewise the Spirit also helps in <u>our weaknesses</u>. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but <u>the Spirit Himself makes intercession for</u> <u>us with groanings which cannot be uttered</u>. 27 Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He <u>makes intercession for the</u> <u>saints according to the will of God</u>. 28 And we know that <u>all things work together for good</u> to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.

7A. Praying regularly for others. HOW?

Ephesians 1:16 do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers ...

1 Thessalonians 1:2-3

2 We give thanks to God always for you all, <u>making mention of you</u> in our prayers, 3 remembering without ceasing your work of faith, labor of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father ...

7A. Praying <u>regularly</u> for others. HOW?

2 Timothy 1:3 I thank God, whom I serve with a pure conscience, as my forefathers did, as without ceasing I <u>remember you</u> in my prayers night and day ...

Philemon 1:4 I thank my God, making mention of you always in my prayers

7B. Praying for the <u>salvation</u> of pre-believers:

2 Corinthians 4:4, 6

4 whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.
6 For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to

give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

7B. Praying for the <u>salvation</u> of pre-believers:

2 Corinthians 10:5 casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ ...

Pray the <u>Word</u> of God to cover all the areas of our lives: A. To <u>know</u> God better.

Ephesians 1:17 (NIV) I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know him better.

Jeremiah 9:23-24

23 Thus says the Lord: "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; **24** But

let him who glories glory in this, that he understands

and knows Me, that I am the Lord,

<u>exercising lovingkindness,</u>

<u>judgment, and righteousness</u>

in the earth. For in these I delight," says the Lord.

2 Peter 1:2-4

2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to

us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of

Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have

been given to us **exceedingly great**

and precious promises, that

through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

B. To be filled with the Power of **God's Love**.

Ephesians 3:16-20

16 that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be <u>strengthened</u> with might through His Spirit in the inner man, 17 that <u>Christ may dwell in</u> your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 ... the width and length and depth and height— 19 to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge; that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. 20 Now to <u>Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all</u> that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us ...

C. For your **Spiritual** Life and Growth.

Colossians 1:9-11

9 For this reason we also, since the day we heard it, do not cease to pray for you, and to ask that you may <u>be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding</u>; 10 that you may <u>walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him</u>, being <u>fruitful</u> in every good work and <u>increasing in the knowledge of God</u>;
11 <u>strengthened with all might</u>, according to His glorious power, for all <u>patience and longsuffering</u> with joy ...

D. Pray for bodily healing.

Psalm 107:20 <u>He sent His word and healed</u> them, and delivered them from their destructions.

Proverbs 3:8 It will be <u>health to your</u> <u>flesh</u>, and <u>strength to your bones</u>.

Proverbs 4:22 For they are <u>life</u> to those who find them, and <u>health to all their flesh</u>.



D. Pray for bodily <u>healing</u>.

Isaiah 53:4-5

4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.
5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.



D. Pray for bodily <u>healing</u>.

Exodus 15:26 and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the Lord your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For <u>I am</u> the Lord who heals you."

E. Prayer not to fall - stumble.

2 Peter 1:10 Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your call and election sure, for **if you do these things you will never stumble**...

Jude 24 Now <u>to Him who is able</u> to keep you from stumbling, and to present you <u>faultless</u> before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy ..



F. Pray for healing of <u>Soul-Spirit-Hurts</u>.

i. Apply the <u>blood</u> for cleansing of the hurts, wounds, pains, offense.

2 Corinthians 7:1 Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us <u>cleanse</u> <u>ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit</u>, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.





- F. Pray for healing of Soul-Spirit-Hurts.
 - ii. Apply the <u>Oil Ointment Holy Spirit -</u> <u>Comforter</u>.

John 14:26 [AMP] But <u>the Comforter</u> (Counselor, Helper, Intercessor, Advocate, Strengthener, Standby), <u>the Holy</u> <u>Spirit</u>, Whom the Father will send in My name ...

John 15:26 [AMP] But when <u>the Comforter</u> (Counselor, Helper, Advocate, Intercessor, Strengthener, Standby) comes, Whom I will send to you from the Father,...



G. Pray for <u>wisdom</u>.

James 1:5 If any of you lacks <u>wisdom</u>, <u>let him ask</u> <u>of God</u>, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him.

Isaiah 11:2 The Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the <u>Spirit of wisdom and understanding</u>, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord.



H. Pray for <u>favor</u>.

Psalm 84:11 [NIV] For the Lord God is a sun and shield; <u>the Lord bestows</u> favor and honor; no good

thing does he withhold from those whose walk is blameless.

Psalm 5:12 For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield.

- I. Pray for protection.
 - i. Our 3 spiritual weapons:
 - (1) The <u>Blood of Christ</u>
 - (2) The Name of Jesus
 - (3) The Sword of the Spirit



I. Pray for protection.

ii. Cover the foothold / doorway / ground.

Ephesians 4:26-27

26 "Be angry, and do not sin":do not let the sun go down on your wrath,27 nor give place to the devil.
