Exodus 17:1 – 6

Exodus 17:1

¹Then all the congregation of the children of Israel set out on their journey from the Wilderness of Sin, according to the commandment of the LORD, and camped in Rephidim; but there was no water for the people to drink.

Exodus 17:2

²Therefore the people contended with Moses, and said,
"Give us water, that we may drink."
So Moses said to them,
"Why do you contend with me?
Why do you tempt the LORD?"

Exodus 17:3

³And the people thirsted there for water,
and the people complained against Moses,
and said,

“Why is it you have brought us up
out of Egypt, to kill us and our children
and our livestock with thirst?”

Exodus 17:1 – 6

- ❖ Horeb is Mount Sinai where the Law was given.
The Law revealed our sins & the consequent judgment.
- ❖ Moses was asked to strike the Rock and water will gush forth for the people to drink.

1. The first ROCK at Horeb, Mt Sinai

The Rock at Horeb – Mount Sinai
was a type – symbol of the
Lord Jesus Christ on the Cross.
There He was struck, crucified
and died for our sins

1. The first ROCK at Horeb, Mt Sinai

Isaiah 53:3 - 4

³He is despised and rejected by men,
a Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief.
And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him;
He was despised, and we did not esteem Him.
⁴Surely He has borne our griefs and carried
our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken,
smitten by God, and afflicted.

1. The first ROCK at Horeb, Mt Sinai

Isaiah 53:5 - 6

⁵But He *was* wounded for our transgressions,
He was bruised for our iniquities;
the chastisement for our peace *was* upon Him,
and by His stripes we are healed.

⁶All we like sheep have gone astray;
we have turned, every one, to his own way;
and the LORD has laid on Him
the iniquity of us all.

1. The first ROCK at Horeb, Mt Sinai

The Lord Jesus Christ was judged
on the Cross for you and I.

The Water of Life, the Holy Spirit
was poured for us to drink, this is for all
who look to the Rock, the Lord Jesus Christ.

1. The first ROCK at Horeb, Mt Sinai

This paved the way for the Water of the Holy Spirit gushing out of the Rock
(at Pentecost).

The Holy Spirit is the Water of Life from the Rock at Horeb – Mt. Sinai where Christ was struck / beaten / died.

He – the Spirit of Christ [Philippians 1:19] was given at Pentecost.

⁶So Moses and Aaron went from the presence of the assembly to the door of the tabernacle of meeting, and they fell on their faces. And the glory of the LORD appeared to them.

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

Numbers 20:6 – 13

⁷Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
⁸“Take the rod; you and your brother Aaron
gather the congregation together.

Speak to the rock before their eyes, and
it will yield its water; thus you shall bring water
for them out of the rock, and give drink
to the congregation and their animals.”

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

Numbers 20:6 – 13

⁹So Moses took the rod from before the LORD as He commanded him. ¹⁰And Moses and Aaron gathered the assembly together before the rock; and he said to them,
“Hear now, you rebels! Must we bring water for you out of this rock?”

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

Numbers 20:6 – 13

¹¹And Moses lifted up his hand and with his rod he smote the rock twice. And the water came out abundantly, and the congregation drank, and their livestock. ¹²And the Lord said to Moses and Aaron, because you did not believe in Me to sanctify Me in the eyes of the Israelites, you therefore shall not bring this congregation into the land which I have given them.

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

Numbers 20:6 – 13

¹³These are the waters of Meribah [strife], where the Israelites contended with the Lord and He showed Himself holy among them.

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

This is our Walk of Faith

This incident at Kadesh took place 40 years later before Israel entered the Promised Land

Kadesh is at the gateway to the promised land.

Horeb typifies the Cross where Jesus was struck, crucified and died.

Kadesh represents our position just before we inherit the promises

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

This is our Walk of Faith

the Bride without spot and blemish
holy and blameless

Kadesh is the place of holiness.

Moses was commanded in Kadesh
to SPEAK to the Rock.

through faith & patience inherit the promises

trial of our faith

James 1:2 - 4 & Romans 5:3 - 5

trial - perseverance - character - hope - love

This is our Walk of Faith

⁷ For we walk by faith, not by sight.

2. The Second ROCK at Kadesh

- Now here in Kadesh, we speak to the Rock. This is a relationship of faith & trust.
- We speak to God – we commune with Him.
- We draw near to Him and He will draw near to us !

Summary – Living water from the ROCK

1. The Holy Spirit comes because of the CROSS when Jesus was struck.

2. The Holy Spirit comes because of FAITH as we speak to the Rock.
