- I. The source of our love.
  - 1. The source of our love is from God.

1 John 4:16b God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.



- I. The source of our love.
  - 2. This love of God flows into us as we abide in Him.

1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.



- I. The source of our love.
  - 3. When we do not abide in God, we revert to our natural corrupt love.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ...



- I. The source of our love.
  - We must <u>first</u> experience the love of God <u>personally</u>.
- 1 John 4:10 In this is love, <u>not that we loved God</u>, <u>but that</u>
  <u>He loved us</u> and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.



- I. The source of our love.
  - **5A.** As we continue to <u>experience</u> the love of God, we will develop <u>faith conviction</u> that we are deeply loved by God.
- 1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.



- I. The source of our love.
  - **5B.** We then <u>live</u> out our lives based on this faith conviction that we are deeply loved by God.
- 1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

- I. The source of our love.
  - 6. We can then love God because He first loved us.
- 1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.



- I. The source of our <u>love</u>.
  - We then continue to experience the <u>flow</u> of the love of God which has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit.

Romans 5:5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the <u>love</u> of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.



- I. The source of our <u>love</u>.
  - 8. We can then love others with the love of God:
    - A. Our families.
- **1 Timothy 5:8** But if anyone does not provide for <u>his own</u>, and especially for those of <u>his household</u>, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.




- I. The source of our love.

**Galatians 6:10** Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.




- I. The source of our love.
  - 8. We can then love others with the love of God:
    - C. Those who cross our path.

Luke 10:29-37 Good Samaritan - Who is my neighbour?





Philippians 1:9-11 (AMP) And this I pray: that your love may abound yet more and more and extend to its fullest development in knowledge and all keen insight [that your love may display itself in greater depth of acquaintance and more comprehensive discernment]







- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - so that we <u>discern</u> what is God's <u>best</u> for the person and love <u>accordingly</u>.

  - 2. as we love with the love of God, we will be sincere and blameless before God.

- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - 2. as we love with the love of God, we will be sincere and blameless before God.
- **1 Corinthians 10:31** Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, we must also strive to have our <u>conscience</u> clear before God and man.

Acts 24:16 This being so, I myself <u>always strive to have</u> a conscience without offense toward God and men.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, we must also strive to have our <u>conscience</u> clear before God and man.
- 1 Corinthians 8:7 However, there is <u>not in everyone that knowledge</u>; for some, with consciousness of the idol, until now eat it as a thing offered to an idol; and <u>their conscience</u>, <u>being weak</u>, <u>is defiled</u>.



- **III.** Desired outcome of loving others:
  - **4.** as we love with the love of God, we must be mindful of those with <u>weak</u> conscience so as not to stumble them.
- 1 Corinthians 8:9 But beware lest somehow this liberty of yours become a <a href="mailto:stumbling-block">stumbling block</a> to those who are weak.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, we must be mindful of those with <u>weak</u> conscience so as not to stumble them.

## Romans 14:12-13

12 So then each of us shall give account of himself to God.
 13 Therefore let us not judge one another anymore, but rather resolve this, not to put a stumbling block or a cause to fall in our brother's way.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, it will be filled with the fruit of Righteousness.

Philippians 1:11 being filled with the <u>fruits of righteousness</u> which are by Jesus Christ, <u>to the glory and praise of God</u>.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, it will be filled with the fruit of <u>Righteousness</u>. Righteousness =
    - A. Right standing with God
    - B. Right believing
    - C. Right doing living



- **III.** Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, it will be filled with the fruit of <u>Righteousness</u>.

Fruits of Righteousness - e.g. Forgiveness

- i. Forgive as an act of our will in obedience.
- ii. Be healed from the wounds, hurts and pains.
- iii. Release judgment of the people to the Lord.



- III. Desired outcome of loving others:
  - as we love with the love of God, it will be filled with the fruit of <u>Righteousness</u>.
     Fruits of Righteousness - e.g. <u>Forgiveness</u>
    - iv. Reconcile
    - v. Restore
    - vi. Rejoice Celebrate



- **III.** Desired outcome of loving others:
  - 5. as we love with the love of God, it will be filled with the fruit of Righteousness.

**Isaiah 32:17** (NIV) The <u>fruit of that righteousness</u> will be peace; its effect will be quietness and confidence for ever.

**Isaiah 32:17** (NKJV) The <u>work of righteousness</u> will be peace, and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance forever.
