


Review of Hearing God


- Know that the Holy Spirit dwells in us and we must intentionally posture to connect with Him.
- II. Know that God loves us and use many <u>vehicles</u> and <u>channels</u> to speak to us.
- III. Through the many vehicles and channels, we receive and hear God speaking primarily in our inner-being i.e. spirit and soul.
- IV. Hearing God <u>plus</u> doing His Word bring increasing Wisdom for life and increasing Revelation.



Colossians 1:9-12 (NIV)

9 For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all spiritual wisdom and understanding. 10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, 11 being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and joyfully 12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.

Jeremiah 9:23-24

23 Thus says the Lord: "Let not the wise man glory in his wisdom, let not the mighty man glory in his might, nor let the rich man glory in his riches; 24 but let him who glories glory in this, that he <u>understands and knows Me</u>, that I am the Lord, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the Lord.

Matthew 5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

1. Obedience.

Luke 3:21-22

21 When all the people were baptized, it came to pass that Jesus also was baptized; and while He prayed, the heaven was opened. 22 And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

2. Faith.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please <u>Him</u>, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

3. Worship.

John 4:23-24

23 But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. 24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."

Mathew 16:24-27

24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross, and follow Me. 25 For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will find it. 26 For what profit is it to a man if he gains the whole world, and loses his own soul? Or what will a man give in exchange for his soul? 27 For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to his works.



Ephesians 2:10 For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for <u>good works</u>, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.

Luke 4:18 The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, because He has anointed Me to <u>preach the gospel</u> to the poor; He has sent Me to <u>heal the broken-hearted</u>, to proclaim <u>liberty to the captives</u> and recovery of <u>sight to the blind</u>, to <u>set at liberty those who are oppressed</u> ...

John 15:5 I am the vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

Colossians 1:10 And we pray this in order that you may live a life worthy of the Lord and may please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God ... (NIV)

2 Peter 3:18 But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.

Philippians 3:10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death ...

Colossians 1:11 being <u>strengthened</u> with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great <u>endurance</u> and patience, and joyfully ... (NIV)

James 1:3-4

3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces <u>patience</u>. 4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be <u>perfect and complete</u>, lacking nothing.

Romans 5:3-5

3 And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; 4 and perseverance, character; and character, hope. 5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

VI. A life of gratefulness.

Colossians 1:12 giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of the saints in the kingdom of light.



for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

VI. A life of gratefulness.

Romans 1:21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.
