







## Evidence of Faith

How do we build and grow in faith?

1. Faith is a <u>gift</u> from God.

Romans 12:3 For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.



How do we build and grow in faith?

2. From God's perspective, He has already given us <u>all</u> the faith for <u>all</u> the needs in our lives.



How do we build and grow in faith?

 From the believer's perspective, our faith "grows" as we journey in <u>revelation</u> and <u>experience</u> with God.




How do we build and grow in faith?

2 Peter 1:2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the <u>knowledge of God</u> and of <u>Jesus our Lord</u>, 3 as His divine power has <u>given to us all things that pertain</u> to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us <u>exceedingly great and precious promises</u>, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.



Obstacles to Faith -What are they?

B. Failure to grow roots of faith.

Matthew 13:20 But he who received the seed on stony places, this is he who hears the word and immediately receives it with joy; 21 yet he has <u>no root</u> in himself, but endures only for a while. For when tribulation or persecution arises because of the word, immediately he stumbles.

How to overcome (A) Evil One and (B) No Roots?

Proverbs 4:20 My son, give attention to my words; incline your <u>ear</u> to my sayings. 21 Do not let them depart from your <u>eyes</u>; keep them in the midst of your <u>heart</u>;
22 for they are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh. 23 Keep your <u>heart</u> with all diligence, for out of it spring the issues of life.

## c. Love of the world.


Matthew 13:22 Now he who received seed among the <u>thorns</u> is he who hears the word, and the <u>cares of</u> <u>this world</u> and the <u>deceitfulness of riches choke</u> <u>the word</u>, and he becomes unfruitful.

c. Love of the <u>world</u>. Examples:



i. Do not be <u>double</u>-minded.

ii. Be rooted and established in the **Father's Love**.

1 John 2:15 Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. 16 For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

1 John 2:15-16



How to overcome love of the **world**?

iii. Grow in our faith in <u>God</u> and <u>His Word</u>.


1 John 5:4 For <u>whatever is born of God overcomes</u> <u>the world</u>. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—<u>our faith</u>. 5 Who is he who overcomes the world, but <u>he who believes that Jesus is the Son of God</u>?

## How to overcome love of the world?

iv. Appropriate the **Divine Exchange** in Christ.

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that <u>in Me</u> you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, <u>I have overcome the world</u>."



D. The <u>sin</u> that so easily entangles.

Hebrews 12:1 Therefore we also, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares us, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us ...



Romans 6:11 Likewise you also, <u>reckon yourselves</u> to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus our Lord.




- E. The weight / baggage that holds us down.

    - v. Certain Activities




How do we build and grow in faith?

2 Corinthians 4:13 And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak ...

For faith to manifest in our lives, we must: 5. D. Starve our doubts and grow our faith.
