

We know the Names of God by Revelation.


Psalm 9:10 - those who know Your Name will put their trust in You

A restored knowledge / revelation of God brings faith up.

































6. Then God created the <u>living creatures</u> in the sky, on the earth and under the earth.

Genesis 1:20-25
20Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of <u>living creatures</u>, and let <u>birds</u> fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens."
21So God created <u>great sea creatures</u> and <u>every living</u> <u>thing</u> that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and <u>every winged bird</u> according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.
