Message Summary

Spiritual Objective: Understanding how to be sanctified this new season

We are already well into the first week of 2014, and the change in the year marks a change in our life season as well. The speaker exhorts us to leave the past behind and challenges us to think of how we will go forward. In this sermon, he exhorts us to consider four areas of our lives.

1. New Schedule- New Season

- Isaiah 43:18-19
- Ecclesiastes 3:1

2. New Slippers- New Walk

- Walk circumspectly/intentionally/deliberately (Eph 5:15a)
- Not as fools, but as wise (Eph 5:15b)
- Redeeming the time (Psalm 39:4, 90:10, Eph 5:15-16)
- Understand what the will of the Lord is (Eph 5:15-17)
- Fully pleasing Him (Col 1:10a)
- Being fruitful in every good work (Col 1:10)
- Increasing in the knowledge of God (Col 1:10b)
- Walk worthy of the calling (Eph 4:1)
- Walk as Jesus walked (1 John 2:6)

3. New Running Shoes- New Capacities

- Jeremiah 12: 15: Running with horses, indicative of capacity
- 1 John 2: 12-14: Growing in capacity
- Guard our emotional capacity
 - A. Choose the battles to fight
 - B. In the process, when cut and hurt, always be healed as soon as possible
 - C. Don't allow words to easily hurt you
 - D. Guard against bitterness
 - E. Seek to always replenish your emotional tank
 - F. Aim to be emotionally fully fit all the time
 - G. Spend time with people who fill you up emotionally
 - H. Connect with God in thanksgiving, praise and worship
 - I. Let the peace of Christ rule in the heart
 - J. Don't give the devil or self a ground to be derailed

4. New Laptop- New Connect

- Hebrews 8:10; 10:16
- Prayer: Communicating with God all the time
- Revelation: Ongoing continual revelation from God
