




Pornography

- I. Every sin we commit is outside our body except sexual sins.
 - Other than sexual sins, we can make <u>restitution</u> from most sins when we <u>confess</u> and <u>reconcile</u> with the person affected.

 - e.g. #2 Gossip, Backbite, Slander

















- That soul-tie is controlled by an unclean and filthy demonic spirit that defiles our spirit and body.

5. There is a close co-relation between <u>sexual</u> sins and <u>idolatry-occult</u>.

Numbers 25:1-3 Now Israel remained in Acacia Grove, and the people began to <u>commit harlotry</u> with the women of Moab. They invited the people to the <u>sacrifices of their gods</u>, and the <u>people ate and bowed down to their gods</u>. So <u>Israel was joined to Baal of Peor</u>, and the anger of the Lord was aroused against Israel.

- 1 Kings 11:1-2 But King Solomon loved many foreign women, as well as the daughter of Pharaoh: women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Sidonians, and Hittites—from the nations of whom the Lord had said to the children of Israel, "You shall not intermarry with them, nor they with you. Surely they will turn away your hearts after their gods.

1 Kings 11:4-5, 7-8 For it was so, when Solomon was old, that his wives turned his heart after other gods; ... And he did likewise for all his foreign wives, who burned incense and sacrificed to their gods.



Leviticus 18:3 According to the doings of the land of Egypt, where you dwelt, you shall not do; and according to the doings of the land of Canaan, where I am bringing you, you shall not do; nor shall you walk in their ordinances.










C. I must get <u>rid</u> of all materials that are linked to my sexual sins.






































B. When we experience the truth, we will walk in freedom.

C. We need a <u>revelation</u> of our identity in Christ.i. We are the <u>righteousness</u> of God in Christ.

12 Therefore do not let <u>sin reign</u> in your mortal body, that you should obey it in its lusts.


14 For sin shall not have dominion over you, for you are not under law but under grace.

There is no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you are his wife.


How then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?"

And it came to pass, when she pestered him daily with her words and pressed him, so that his soul was vexed to death ...




D. Live out from our identity in Christ.
