Introduction



Like a handphone, it must have power and strong signal i.e. it must be properly connected.



Introduction

- Every believer wants to have his prayer heard and answered.
- Every believer must have the conviction that his prayers are actually heard by God.

Luke 11:1 Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." This must be the longing and desire of every believer to grow his prayer-life

and to pray effectively.

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Grace of God.

Mercy means the negative bad consequences that is due to us have been averted or mitigated by God.

Hebrews 4:16

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may **OBTAIN MERCY** and find grace to help in time of need.

 - rituals.
 - iust more saving nravers

D. Prayer is **Communion** with God.

Adam and Eve

- nobody to intercede
- no demons to cast out
- no kingdoms to tear down
- no clothes, food, houses or jobs to believe for
- no petitions at all



D. Prayer is <u>Communion</u> with God.

Adam and Eve

- Yet they met with God every evening in the cool of the day and communed with Him.
- The conversations with God had nothing in them concerning sin, lack, need, problems, repenting, begging or pleading.
- Yet they prayed, communed with God every day.

e.g. 1 - No Guilt & No Condemnation

Romans 8:1 There is therefore now <u>no condemnation</u> <u>to those who are in Christ Jesus</u>, who do not <u>walk</u> according to the flesh, but <u>according to the Spirit</u>.
