Romans 5:17b

much more those who receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life

through the One, Jesus Christ

not self, not your boss, not your god-father, not your friend, family member or leader!

I. We reign in life through the Lord Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 2:6 and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus

Colossians 1:17 And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

1 Timothy 2:5 1 Corinthians 1:30 Divine-Exchange

II. We reign in life with the Gift of Righteousness.

2 Corinthians 5:21

For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

i.e. We have **<u>Right Standing</u>** with God

- Romans 5:1 Peace with God
- Romans 8:31 If God is for us, who can be against us?
- Romans 8:33 Who can bring any charge against us?
- Romans 8:34 Who is he that condemns
- Romans 8:35 Who shall separate us from the love of God?
- Romans 8:37 More than conquerors!

III. As we develop the Spirit of Faith.

2 Corinthians 4:13

And since we have the same spirit of faith, according to what is written, "I believed and therefore I spoke," we also believe and therefore speak ...

Our lives must be build and lived <u>COMPLETELY</u> on the <u>WORD</u> of God! be glorified be magnified be praised

III. As we develop the Spirit of Faith.

This is the principle of <u>believing</u> and <u>speaking</u> the Word of God.

 To believe, we must <u>hear</u> the Word of Faith i.e. Rhema.

Romans 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

 To hear the Word of Faith [Rhema], we must regularly <u>partake</u> the Logos of the Word.



- A. Partake because the Word is spiritual food for our <u>spirit</u>-man.
 - > 1 Peter 2:2 Milk
 - Matthew 4:4 Bread
 - > Hebrews 5:14 Meat

3. As we hear and partake of the Word, we must <u>believe</u> in our heart.

Romans 10:9-10

9that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and **believe in your heart** that God has raised Him, from the dead, you will be saved.

10For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

4. As we believe, we must <u>speak</u> forth what we believe.

2 Corinthians 1:20 For all the promises of God in Him

are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.

 As we believe, we must <u>speak</u> forth what we believe. Speaking forth the Word is a range of activities:

Pray Thanksgiving Read Spiritual Songs Worship Proclaim Sing Mutter Shout Praise Whisper Declare

Proverbs 18:21

Death and life are in the **power of the tongue**; and those who love it will eat its fruit.

5. As we speak, we will receive the Promise of God.

Romans 10:9-10

9that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. 10For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Mark 11:23-24

23For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done,

he will have whatever he says

24Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

5. As we speak, we will <u>receive</u> the Promise of God.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.



III. As we develop the Spirit of Faith.

This is the principle of <u>believing</u> and <u>speaking</u> the Word of God.

 It is important to note that what we believe and speak must be from the Word of God.

2. We must <u>intentionally</u> come to the Throne of Grace.

Hebrews 4:16 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.



2. We must intentionally come to the Throne of Grace.

Note : It is the Throne of Grace and not the Throne of Judgement

Importance of confidence and boldness to do so because of the Blood of Christ and through Jesus, our Great High Priest.

- We must <u>find</u> the grace that we need. To <u>find</u> suggests we <u>know</u> how to access:
 - A. All the grace that we need are in the <u>heavenly</u> realms.

D. We must know we have access to the grace.

Romans 5:2

through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.



2 Peter 1:3-4

3as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, **through the knowledge of Him** who called us by glory and virtue, 4by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust. IV. We must intentionally <u>appropriate</u> the grace that we need.

Ignorance is NOT bliss

v. To reign in life with Christ, we must **daily** <u>believe</u> and <u>speak</u> the Word.

- 1. We must <u>hear</u> the Word to believe.
- 2. We must <u>speak</u> what we believe.
- 3. We then receive what we speak.
- We receive first in the <u>spirit</u> realm which is then manifested in the <u>physical natural</u> realm.

- (1) Health and Healing [Proverbs 3:8, 4:22]
- (2) I am very deeply <u>loved</u> by God [John 3:16]
- (3) I am completely <u>forgiven</u> in Christ. [Hebrews 10:17 - My sins He remember no more
- (4) I have the gift of <u>righteousness</u> which is the Righteousness of <u>God</u> [Romans 5:17, 2 Corinthians 5:21]
