I. <u>Decide</u> to worship God.

Psalm 34:1 **Will** bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.

Psalm 138:1-2

1 **Will** praise You with my whole heart; before the gods **Will** sing praises to You. 2 **Will** worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkind-ness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.



I. <u>Decide</u> to worship God.

2 Samuel 6:16 (The Story of Michal) Now as the ark of the LORD came into the City of David, <u>Michal</u>, Saul's daughter, <u>looked through a window</u> and <u>saw</u> King David leaping and whirling before the LORD; and she <u>despised him in her heart</u>.

v23 - she became barren!

II. Be a <u>true worshipper</u>.1. In <u>Spirit</u>.

1 Corinthians 2:11 For what man knows the things of a man except <u>the spirit of the man</u> which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God.



II. Be a <u>true worshipper</u>.1. In <u>Spirit</u>.

Philippians 3:3 For <u>we</u> are the circumcision, who worship God in the Spirit, rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have <u>no confidence in</u> the flesh ...



II. Be a <u>true worshipper</u>.2. In <u>Truth</u>.

Psalm 51:6 Behold, You desire <u>truth in the inward</u> parts, and in the hidden part You will make me to know wisdom.



II. Be a <u>true worshipper</u>.2. In <u>Truth</u>.

John 17:17 <u>Sanctify them by Your truth</u>. Your word is truth.



II. Be a <u>true worshipper</u>. *PRAY Now:*

Father-God, I come to Your Holy Presence. I choose to be a true worshipper. I want to worship You in spirit and in truth. I give You my heart - cleanse it Lord. Guide me by Your Word of Truth - Jesus my Lord! Lead me - Holy Spirit of Truth. In Jesus name!



III. <u>Know</u> we have right standing with God.

Psalm 24:3-4 3 Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? Or who may stand in His holy place? 4 He who has **clean hands and a pure heart**, who has not lifted up his soul to an idol, nor sworn deceitfully.





III. <u>Know</u> we have right standing with God.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that <u>we might become</u> <u>the righteousness of God in Him</u>.

Hebrews 10:19-21

19 Therefore, brethren, having <u>boldness to enter</u> <u>the Holiest by the blood of Jesus</u>, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a <u>High</u> <u>Priest</u> over the house of God ...



 III. <u>Know</u> we have right standing with God. On the believer's part, the issue is one of <u>conscience</u>.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to **forgive** us our sins and to **cleanse** us from all unrighteousness.

Hebrews 10:22 let us <u>draw near</u> with a true heart in <u>full assurance of faith</u>, <u>having our hearts</u> <u>sprinkled from an evil conscience</u> and our <u>bodies</u> <u>washed with pure water</u>.



III. <u>Know</u> we have right standing with God. Declare:

- I am deeply loved by God
- I am completely forgiven in Christ
- I come boldly to the Presence of God by the Blood of the Lamb and through Jesus, my High Priest



III. <u>Know</u> we have right standing with God. Declare:

- I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus!
- I have right standing with God!
- Yes and Amen!
- Thank You Lord!

IV. With freedom from the <u>cares</u> and <u>anxieties</u> of life.

1 Peter **5:7** casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Philippians 4:6-7





V. With <u>thanksgiving</u>.

Psalm 50:14 Sacrifice thank offerings to God ...

Psalm 100:4 Enter his gates with thanksgiving ... give thanks to him and praise his name.



V. With <u>thanksgiving</u>.



We thank God for all He has done and is doing ... given and going to give to us.

Psalm 103:1-5 Bless the LORD, O my soul ... and forget not all His benefits: Who forgives ... heals ... redeems ... crowns ... satisfies ... renew ...

The Bottom Line of Thanksgiving is <u>Gratefulness</u>.

for the Lord's Supper

Thanks be to God for His Indescribable Gift - 2 Corinthians 9:15 -

Give thanks for the Bread - the Body of Christ

- 1. He died for our salvation (Romans 10:9-10).
- 2. He died to forgive us of our sins (Ephesians 1:7).
- 3. He died to include us in His **Body** (1 Corinthians 12:12-13).
- **4.** He died to give us <u>life</u> (1 Corinthians 15:45).
- 5. He died for our **bodily healing** (Matthew 8:16-17).

Give thanks for the Cup - the Blood of Christ

- 1. His Blood was shed to <u>cleanse</u> our sins (Hebrews 9:22).
- 2. His Blood was shed to <u>cover</u> our sins (1John 2:2).
- 3. His Blood was the seal of the New Covenant (1 Corinthians 11:25).
- 4. His Blood gives us <u>life</u> (Hebrews 9:14-15).
- 5. We <u>overcome</u> the evil one by His Blood (Revelation12:11).



VI. With praise.

Psalm 100:4 (NIV) **Enter** his gates with thanksgiving and **his courts with praise**; give thanks to him and praise his name.



VI. With praise.



We praise God for Who He is: <u>His Attributes</u>, <u>His Names</u>.

Hebrews 13:15 (NIV) Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of <u>lips that confess his name</u>.

The Bottom Line of Praise is <u>Knowing</u> God.



VI. With praise.

Praise is vocal. It is never silent.

Psalm 95:1 Come, let us sing for joy to the LORD; let us shout aloud to the Rock of our salvation.

Psalm 66:1-2
1 Shout with joy to God, all the earth!
2 Sing the glory of his name; make his praise glorious!

Leviticus 10:3 And Moses said to Aaron, "This is what the LORD spoke, saying: 'By those who come near ME I must be regarded as holy; and before all the people I must be glorified.""

Isaiah 8:13 (NIV) <u>The LORD Almighty is the one</u> <u>you are to regard as holy</u>, he is the one you are to fear, he is the one you are to dread ...

Matthew 6:10 Hallowed be Your NAME

Psalm 46:10 <u>Be still</u>, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!

2. Worship has got to do with <u>developing</u> <u>intimacy with God</u>.

Matthew 22:37 (NIV) Jesus said to him, 'You shall <u>love</u> the LORD your God with <u>all your heart</u>, with <u>all your soul</u>, and with <u>all your mind</u>.'

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us!



VII. With worship.

- Worship has got to do with <u>developing</u> <u>intimacy with God</u>.
 - A. Directing our <u>thoughts</u> and <u>emotions</u> to God.
 - **B.** Giving Him our <u>love</u> and <u>adoration</u> in response to His love for us.

The Bottom Line of Worship is <u>Surrender</u>.

- i. <u>Spiritual Songs;</u>
- ii. <u>New Songs;</u>
- iii. Spontaneous Songs

in worship.

The place of <u>Spiritual Songs / New</u> <u>Spontaneous Songs</u>.

Ephesians 5:18-19 ... be filled with the Spirit,

speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and **spiritual songs**, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord ...

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and <u>spiritual</u> <u>songs</u>, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.



Spiritual Songs / New Songs

- (1) <u>Spontaneous</u> expressions of our spirit that are improvised in an unrehearsed, unpremeditated manner.
- (2) <u>Creative</u> expressions to tell God what we think and feel about Him.
- (3) Born out of <u>faith</u> and the <u>inspiration</u> of the Holy Spirit.
- (4) Saying or singing personal prayer tongues.





The Bottom Line

Revelation 4:8 The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of <u>eyes</u> around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: "Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!"
