## 2. SANCTIFY US

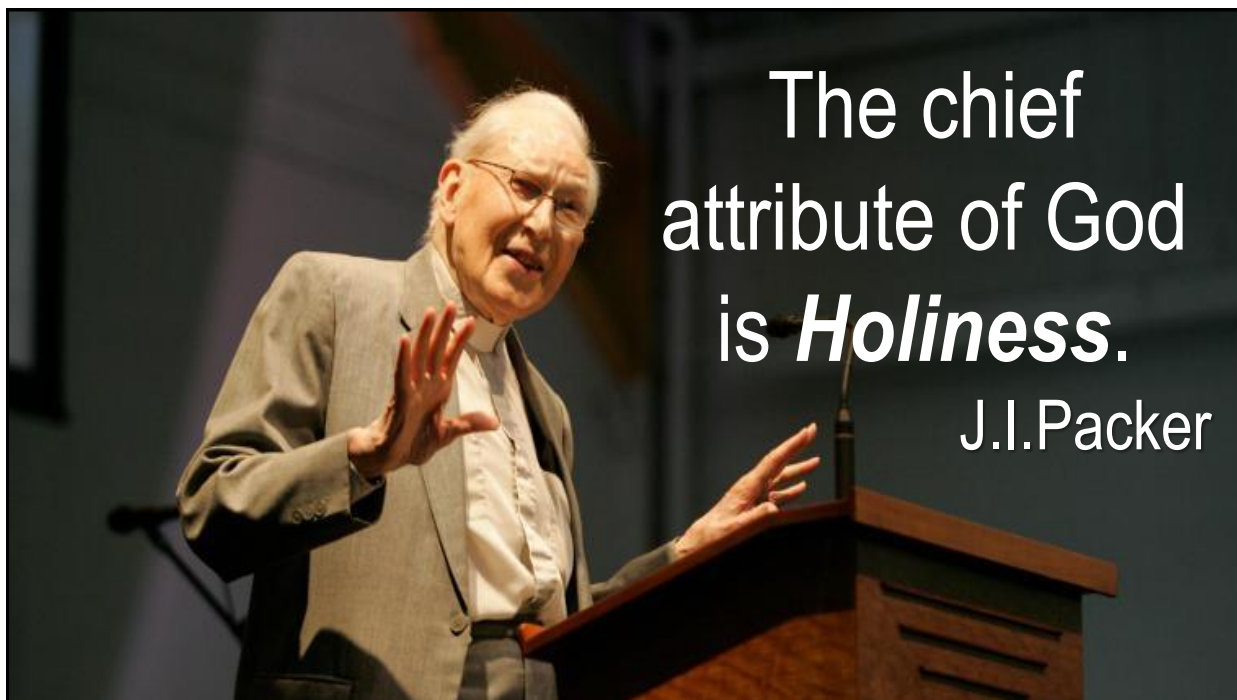


**4** And the foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of him who called, and the house was filled with smoke.

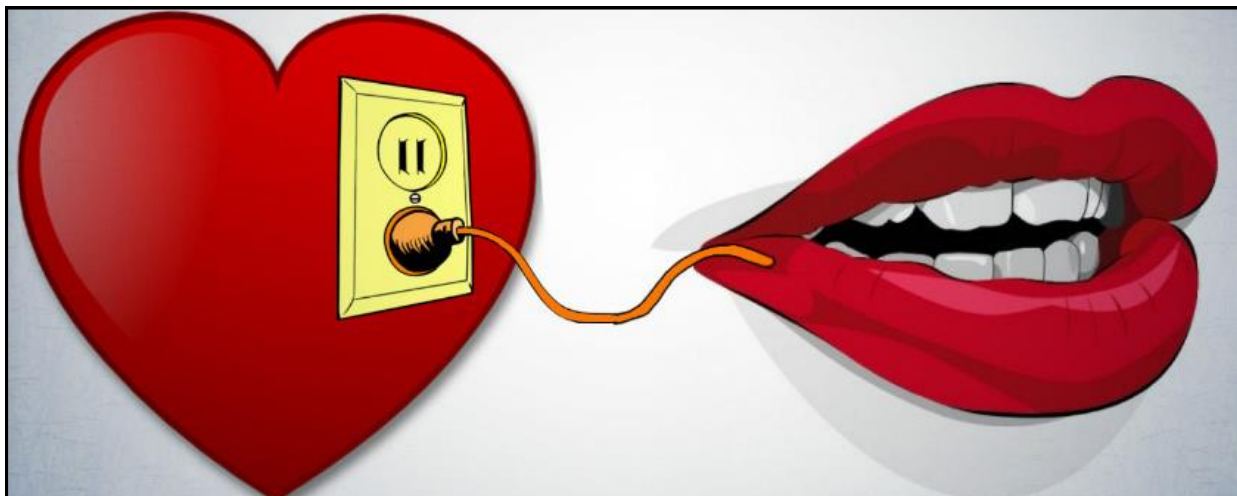

angels or men.



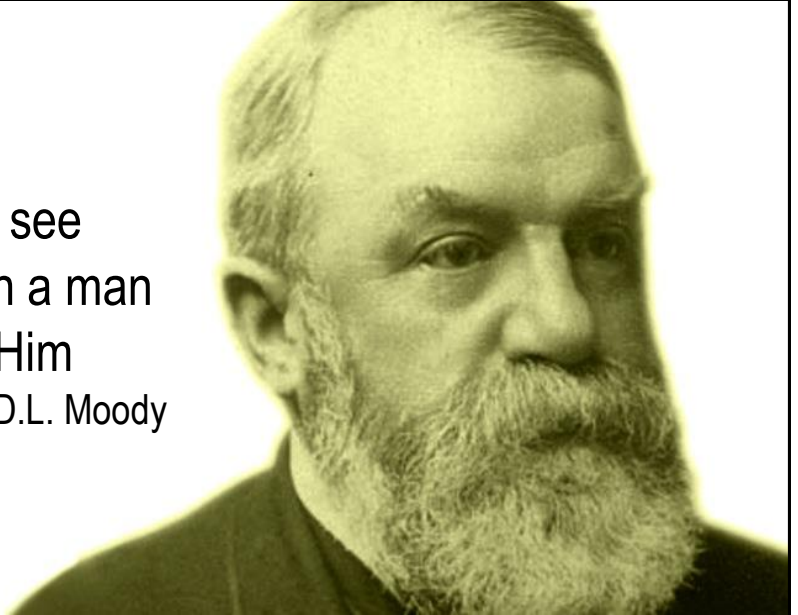
1. **Do our daily quiet time regularly.**

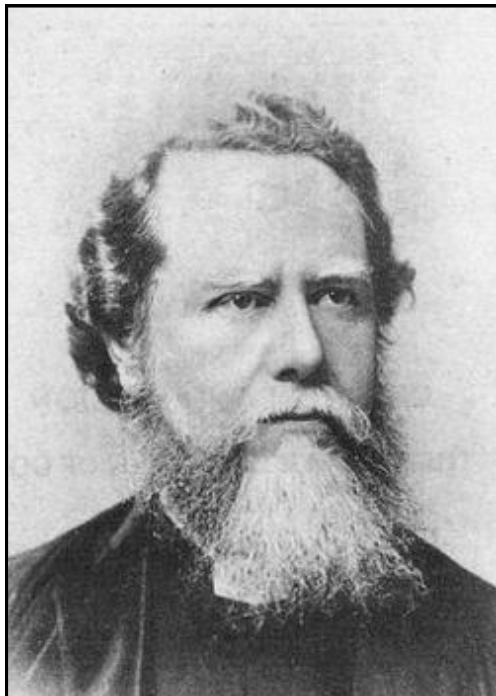
# 3. SEND US
