Revelation 2:1-7



II. Christ Jesus

1. He who <u>holds</u> the seven stars in His right hand.

II. Christ Jesus

2. He who <u>walks</u> in the midst of the seven golden lampstands.

Revelation 2:1b "To the angel of the church of Ephesus write, "These things says He who holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the midst of the seven golden lampstands:

Revelation 1:20c ... and the seven lampstands which you saw are the seven churches.

III. Commendation

 Ephesus Church was <u>diligent</u>, <u>steadfas</u> <u>persevering</u> in the Lord.

Revelation 2:2a I know your works, your labour your patience ...

Revelation 2:3 and you <u>have persevered and</u> <u>have patience</u>, and <u>have laboured</u> for My name's sake and have <u>not become weary</u>.

2. Ephesus Church loved <u>Righteousness</u> and <u>Holiness</u>.

3. Ephesus Church was discerning.

Revelation 2:2c And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not, and have found them liars

Hebrews 1:9a You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness ...

III. Commendation

3. Ephesus Church was discerning.

Hebrews 5:14 But <u>solid food</u> belongs to those who are of <u>full age</u>, that is, those who by <u>reason of use</u> have their <u>senses exercised to discern both good and evil</u>.

Example: Knowing God [Jeremiah 9:24]

- A. God is <u>simultaneously</u> loving, just and righteous B. God's love can never compromise His righteousn
- B. God's love can never <u>compromise</u> His righteousness
 C. God's love is always <u>circumscribed</u> by His righteousness





IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love

1. As none of us can love God on our own, the first love is our <u>experiencing</u> the love of God <u>firstly</u>.

1 John 4:10 In this is love, <u>not that we loved God</u>, <u>but that He loved us</u> and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

We must <u>first</u> experience His love.



IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love

 We can then love God as our <u>response</u> to Him <u>first</u> loving us.

1 John 4:19 We love Him because He first loved us.

IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love

3. We must continue to <u>receive</u> and <u>abide</u> in the love of God.

1 John 4:16 And we have <u>known</u> and <u>believed</u> the <u>love that God has for us</u>. God is love, and <u>he who abides in love</u> <u>abides in God</u>, and <u>God in him</u>.

IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love

 The love of God will fill our hearts to mould our <u>attitudes</u> and <u>motivations</u> in relating to others in life, work and ministry.

Romans 5:5 Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in our hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to us. IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love
 5A. When we fail to experience and abide in the love of God, we will revert to our carnal-corrupt-natural love manifested in performance in works and religious practices.
 5B. This was what happened to the church at Ephesus. This is what was meant as leaving our first love.

IV. Complaint - Left Our First Love

1 Thessalonians 1:3 remembering without ceasing your <u>work of faith, labour of love</u>, and <u>patience of hope</u> in our Lord Jesus Christ in the sight of our God and Father ...

Hebrews 6:1 - Dead Works Therefore, leaving the discussion of the elementary principles of Christ, let us go on to perfection, not laying again the foundation of repentance from dead works and of faith toward God ...




V. <u>Counsel</u> and Warning Revelation 2:5 Remember therefore from where you have fallen; <u>repent</u> and <u>do the first</u> <u>works</u>, or else I will come to you quickly and <u>remove your lampstand from</u> <u>its place</u>—unless you <u>repent</u>.

V. Counsel

- <u>Repent</u> and **do** the <u>first</u> works of your <u>first</u> love.
 - Revelation 2:5b repent and do the first works
 - A. Continually abide and receive the <u>love</u> of God.
 - B. <u>Connect</u> with God always.





<u>Repent</u> and <u>do</u> the <u>first</u> works of your <u>first</u> love.

- E. Don't be cold nor lukewarm, but be <u>hot</u> for God, have <u>passion</u> for God!
- F. Don't just have a relationship with God but build a <u>vibrant</u> one.
 - sensitive to HS [conscience]
 - knowing & hearing God
 - learning & growing spiritually

 - **G.** Live in continual <u>surrender</u> to know the GAP will of God.
 - **H.** Live in total <u>dependency</u> on the Holy Spirit.
