


Psalm 103:1 Bless the LORD, O my soul; and all that is within me, bless His holy name!

Essence of Praise - Know God - Know His Name



5 Major Themes to bless-praise the Lord:

I. Forgiveness - He forgives all our iniquities.

II. Healing - He heals all our diseases.

III. Protection - He redeems our lives from the pit.

IV. Loving-kindness and tender-mercies of God.


V. Life-Giving Pleasures - He satisfies our mouths with good things so that our youth is renewed.

I. Forgiveness - He forgives all our iniquities (v3a)

1. We have all sinned and need forgiveness from God.

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ...

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.



I. Forgiveness - He forgives all our iniquities (v3a)
3. We receive forgiveness of our sins when we confess them to God.

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Forgiveness - He forgives all our iniquities (v3a)
 A. There is always forgiveness available for us in our life-time because Jesus died once and for all for our sins.

Hebrews 9:12 Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

Forgiveness - He forgives all our iniquities (v3a)
 Our struggle with God's forgiveness is in our conscience.

Revelation 12:10 ... for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down.

Source of Guilt and Condemnation

5. Our struggle with God's forgiveness is in our conscience.

2 Corinthians 5:21 For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

Hebrews 9:14 how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

5. Our struggle with God's forgiveness is in our conscience.

Hebrews 10:19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, 20 by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, 21 and having a High Priest over the house of God, 22 let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

Hebrews 10:19-22



II. Healing - He heals all our diseases (v3b)

1. God is our Healer.

Exodus 15:26 and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

II. Healing - He heals all our diseases (v3b)

2. Healing is in the atonement.

Matthew 8:16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."


2. Healing is in the <u>atonement</u>.

1 Peter 2:24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—<u>by whose stripes you were healed</u>.

2. Healing is in the atonement.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. 5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.







4. Healing is appropriated through:

A. The spoken Rhema word.

Luke 7:7 .. But Say the word, and my servant will be healed .. 9 Jesus .. "I say to you, I have not found such great faith! ..." 10 And those who were sent, returning to the house, found the servant well who had been sick.

4. Healing is appropriated through:

A. The spoken Rhema word.

Proverbs 3:8 It [the Word] will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones.

Proverbs 4:22 For they [the Word] are life to those who find them, and health to all their flesh.




4. Healing is appropriated through:

c. Calling for spiritual leaders and anointing with oil.


James 5:14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.



















1. Other than persecution and martyrdom, there is Protection for all God's people who intentionally come under the Blood.

Exodus 12:23 For the LORD will pass through to strike the Egyptians; and when He sees the blood on the lintel and on the two doorposts, the LORD will pass over the door and not allow the destroyer to come into your houses to strike you.




1. Other than persecution and martyrdom, there is Protection for all God's people who intentionally come under the Blood.

1 Peter 1:18 knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers, 19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

1. Other than persecution and martyrdom, there is Protection for all God's people who intentionally come under the Blood.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.



2. Protection is also accessed as we stand upon God's promises. Psalm 20:1; 6 1 May the LORD answer you in the day of trouble; may the name of the God of Jacob defend you ... 6 Now I know that the LORD saves His anointed; He will answer him from His holy heaven with the saving strength of His right hand.

2. Protection is also accessed as we stand upon God's promises. Psalm 23:5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup runs over.

2. Protection is also accessed as we stand upon God's promises. Psalm 27:1 The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid? 2 When the wicked came against me to eat up my flesh, my enemies and foes, they stumbled and fell. 3 Though an army may encamp against me, my heart shall not fear; though war may rise against me, in this I will be confident. Psalm 27:1-3

III. Protection - He redeems our lives from destruction 3. The evil one has access to us when we give him a ground-foothold. Ephesians 4:27 nor give place-ground-foothold to the devil.


IV. Loving-kindness and tender-mercies of God toward us (v4b)

Lamentations 3:22 Through the LORD's mercies we are not consumed, because His compassions fail not. 23 They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. 24 "The LORD is my portion," says my soul, "Therefore I hope in Him!" 25 The LORD is good to those who wait for Him, to the soul who seeks Him. 26 It is good that one should hope and wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD.

Exodus 33:18 And he [Moses] said, "Please, show me Your glory." 19 Then He said, "I will make all My goodness pass before you, and I will proclaim the name of the LORD before you. I will be gracious to whom I will be gracious, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion."

Psalm 103:5 (NIV) who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Genesis 1:28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."


We are always Blessed to be a Blessing to others!

Psalm 84:11 For the LORD God is a sun and shield; the LORD will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly.


