# Grace

- = Receiving what we do not deserve. Unmerited favour out of God's goodness. Unearned.
- = The supply from God for what we need in our lives!
- = God's Favour and Blessing for us!

## Philippians 2:7-8

7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a **bondservant**, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.

Ephesians 2:8a For by grace you have been

saved through faith ...

## I. God's Grace saves us who believe.

1. The <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> paid the price for the Covenant of Grace to us.

## Ephesians 2:8-9

8 For <u>by grace</u> you have been <u>saved</u> through faith, and that <u>not of yourselves</u>; it is the <u>gift</u> <u>of God</u>, 9 <u>not of works</u>, <u>lest anyone should</u> boast.



God's Grace <u>saves</u> us who believe.
 In Christ, Grace and Truth come together.

John 1:14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, <u>full of grace</u> <u>and truth</u>.





2. In Christ, Grace and <u>Truth</u> come together.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am <u>the way</u>, <u>the truth</u>, and <u>the life</u>. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

John 1:17For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.

    - A. The Law shows us what is <u>right</u> and <u>wrong</u>.
    - **B.** The Law points us to the <u>Truth</u>.
    - C. But the Law is <u>powerless</u> to empower us to do right.

Galatians 3:19 What <u>purpose</u> then does <u>the law</u> serve? It was added <u>because of</u> <u>transgressions</u>, <u>till the Seed should come</u> to whom the promise was made; and it was appointed through angels by the hand of a mediator.

2. In Christ, Grace and Truth come together.

## Galatians 3:21, 24

**21** Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For <u>if</u> there had been a <u>law</u> given which <u>could have given life</u>, truly <u>righteousness</u> would have been by the law.

24 Therefore the <u>law was our tutor to bring us</u> to Christ, that we might <u>be justified by faith</u> ...




## I. God's Grace saves us who believe.

  - D. Only faith in Christ justifies us.
  - E. Additionally, faith in Christ empowers us through the Holy Spirit to do right and hence, obey the Law.



## I. God's Grace saves us who believe. 2. In Christ, Grace and <u>Truth</u> come together. **F.** Only by faith in Christ can Grace and Truth be One in our lives. Galatians 2:16 knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law but by faith in Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Christ Jesus, that we might be justified by faith in Christ and not by the works of the law; for by the works of the law no flesh shall be justified.

5 Therefore He who supplies the Spirit to you and works miracles among you, does He do it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?-






## Romans 8:1-2






A. The Word of God heard and received in our spirit-heart produces <u>faith</u>.

**B.** <u>Faith</u> is the <u>key</u> to receive the <u>Grace</u> provided for us.

Romans 5:2 through whom also we have <u>access</u> by faith into this Grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

**D.** We receive the specific grace by <u>faith</u>.


## Romans 10:9-10
