
Obstacles - Hindrances - Mindsets that stifle and block Spiritual Life and Growth - 2 Corinthians 10:4-5

God is LOVE.
Father-God is Love.

1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.

1. There are 7 characteristics of His Love.

Exodus 34:6-7a .. the LORD proclaimed,
"The LORD, the LORD God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, [slow to anger] and abounding in goodness and truth,
7 keeping mercy for thousands [faithfulness], forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin ...



2A. His love is consistent with His two other key attributes of being just and righteous.

Psalm 97:2 ... righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne.

2B. Grace is on the side of truth i.e.

His love does not condone sins and violation of His laws.

John 1:17 For the law was given through Moses, but grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.


2C. He cannot be loving but unjust and unrighteous.

Jeremiah 9:24 But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth.

For in these I delight," says the Lord.


2D. Therefore, there are consequences - curses when we violate the laws of God.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death ...



2D. Therefore, there are <u>consequences</u> - <u>curses</u> when we violate the laws of God.

Exodus 34:7b ... by no means clearing the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children and the children's children to the third and the fourth generation."



Galatians 3:13-14

13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.



2E. God in His love for us, in Christ, has redeemed us from the <u>curse</u> of the law.

- i. God Himself does not curse man.
- ii. He gave man <u>laws</u> and <u>principles</u> of life.
- iii. We obey and flow with them for our well-being and prosperity.
- iv. We disobey and violate them to our loss and destruction.

3A. In His love, He <u>trains</u> and <u>corrects</u> His children.

Hebrews 12:5-11

5 And you have forgotten the exhortation which speaks to you as to sons: "My son, do not despise the <u>chastening</u> of the Lord, nor be discouraged when you are <u>rebuked</u> by Him; 6 For whom the Lord loves He <u>chastens</u>, and <u>scourges</u> every son whom He receives."



Hebrews 12:5-11


7 If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? 8 But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons.

9 Furthermore, we have had human fathers who <u>corrected</u> us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily <u>be in subjection</u> to the Father of spirits and live?



Hebrews 12:5-11

10 For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness.
11 Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.



3C. The consequences of disobedience comes from the Laws and Principles of Life.

e.g.1 Proverbs 16:18 Pride goes before destruction, and a haughty spirit before a fall.

e.g.2 Genesis 31:38-41 every Jacob will find his own Laban.


e.g.3 Proverbs 29:1 destruction and loss to the un-teachable.




4A. He desires for each of us to first

experience His love i.e. connect with
Him as the source of love.

1 John 3:1 Behold what manner of love
the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.



4B. As we experience His love, He desires for each of us to have a conviction of His enduring love for us.
1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.



4D. In His love, He gives good and perfect gifts.

James 1:17 (NIV) Every good and perfect gift is from ... the Father ...

Romans 3:23 for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God ...

John 16:33 These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

4D. In His love, He gives good and perfect gifts.

Luke 11:11-13

11 If a son asks for bread from any father among you, will he give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will he give him a serpent instead of a fish? 12 Or if he asks for an egg, will he offer him a scorpion? 13 If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him!"

4E. His love reaches out to us continually until our last breath.

Romans 2:4 ... the goodness of God leads you to repentance

6 He sacrificed his sons in the fire

✓ practiced sorcery, divination and witchcraft
✓ consulted mediums and spiritists
✓ He did much evil

2 Chronicles 33 - King Manasseh

- 9 did more evil than the nations ...
- 12 In his distress he sought the favor of the Lord is God and humbled himself greatly before the God of his fathers.

4E. His love reaches out to us continually until our last breath.

Example #1 -

- 2 Chronicles 33 King Manasseh
- 13 And when he prayed to Him, the Lord was moved by his entreaty and listened to his plea; so he brought him back to Jerusalem and to his kingdom. Then Manasseh knew that the Lord is God.

17 When he came to his senses ...


- That is the **DEFINING POINT** -

Example #2 -

Luke 15 - Parable of the Prodigal Sons

20 ... while he was still a long way off.



5A. The love of God is unconditional **only** in the sense that He continually reaches out to every person on earth to be reconciled to Him.

Romans 5:6. 8

- 6 For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.
- 8 But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

5A. The love of God is unconditional **only** in the sense that He continually reaches out to every person on earth to be reconciled to Him. Romans 5:10 For if when we were enemies

we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life.



5B. The love of God is <u>abounding</u> to man, for man to <u>respond</u> during the days of his life on earth up to his <u>last breath</u>.

Psalm 103:8 (NIV) The LORD is compassionate and gracious, slow to anger, abounding in love.



5C. The love of God is conditional in the sense that for man to experience His love, man must **call on** the Lord.

Romans 10:13 For "whoever <u>calls</u> on the name of the LORD shall be **saved**."



5D. To call on the Lord is:

i. To come to our senses.

ii. To repent.

iii. To humble ourselves.

iv. To acknowledge God.

v. To seek Him.

James 4:6 But He gives <u>more grace</u>. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, but gives grace to the <u>humble</u>."
