

Man's Rebellion & Fall

Romans 6:23a

For the wages [consequences]

of sin is death ...

- Sickness, Disease, Physical Death
- Spiritual Death = Separation from God
 - Eternal Suffering

Broadly in 3 Categories:

- 1. Affects Man's Relationship with GOD
- 2. Affects Man's Relationship with Man
- 3. Causes the Natural Creation Order to be in disequilibrium [fracture]

Consequences of Sins (Luke 21:25 – 26)



Four Basic Exchanges

Hebrews 2:14-15

¹⁴Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, ¹⁵and <u>release</u> those who through <u>fear of death</u> were all their lifetime subject to <u>bondage</u>.

- Guilt & Condemnation

- Power to overcome sins
 - Freedom in Christ

THE DUAL PROBLEM & SOLUTION

When man fell, sin entered into our soul

- We receive healing by faith in God
- Some things weaken or sabotage our faith
- Some issues that block us from receiving our healing

Unforgiveness Not walking in love
Strife with others, complaining and murmuring
Speaking negative and doubt-filled words
Fear and unbelief Unconfessed areas of sins
Unbelief and doubts about divine healing

God first call us to believe and then we receive.
