


Good News - The Gospel

First problem

- When man fell into sin, the consequence is spiritual death.
- Man will be eternally separated from God.
- He will be cast into the Lake of Fire and tormented forever.

First problem: Spiritual Death



Solution to the First problem

- Jesus died for the salvation of our soul.
- Y He took the punishment on our behalf when He died on the cross.
- His blood was shed for our salvation.
- His blood was shed to redeem our soul.



How to be Saved?

Romans 10:9 - 10 9that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.



How to be Saved?

John 1:12
But as many as received Him,
to them He gave the right
to become children of God,
to those who believe
in His Name



- ✓ When man fell, our bodies are also afflicted with sickness & disease.
- ✓ This body became <u>corrupt</u> and <u>mortal</u> resulting in our physical death.
- ✓ When Jesus comes, we will then have the incorruptible and immortal resurrected body.

Second problem: Physical Death




1 Corinthians 15:52 - 53 ⁵²in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 53For this corruptible must <u>put on</u> incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.



- In the meantime, while on earth before we physically die, we need healing for our sickness & disease.
- Jesus died for <u>healing</u> of our bodies.
- The Body of Christ was broken for our <u>healing</u>.

Second problem: Physical Death



Psalm 103:3 - Who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your diseases

God forgives our iniquities = salvation

God also heals all our diseases



Isaiah 53:5

But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

He was wounded for our transgressions = salvation

By His stripes, we are healed



Jeremiah 17:14
Heal me, O LORD,
and I shall be healed;
save me, and I shall be saved,
for You are my praise.

Healing & Salvation

Healing & Forgiveness




Healing is for NOW while we are on earth

The Issue then, is to understand and to know how, as believers, to appropriate healing

Isaiah 53:4 - 5

⁴Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

Personal Sins (John 5:14)



- Some things weaken or sabotage our faith



Some issues that block us from receiving our healing

Unforgiveness Not walking in love

Strife with others, complaining & murmuring

Speaking negative and doubt-filled words



Some issues that block us from receiving our healing

Fear and unbelief

Unconfessed areas of sins

Unbelief and doubts about divine healing



1. Through Anointed Atmosphere

Luke 5:17b
the power of the Lord was pre

... the power of the Lord was <u>present</u> to heal them.

This can occur during high praise and spiritual worship with the manifest Presence of the Lord sensed by the sick.



2. Through <u>Spiritual Gifts of Miracles</u> and <u>Healings</u> given to certain believers.

1 Corinthians 12:9b – 10a
 9 ...to another gifts of healings
 by the same Spirit, ¹⁰to another the working of miracles ...



3. Through the <u>Prayer of Faith</u>

James 5:15
And the prayer of faith
will save the sick,
and the Lord will raise him up.
And if he has committed sins,
he will be forgiven.



3. Through the <u>Prayer of Faith</u>

The faith can be:-

a. Of the Pray-er (Acts 3:6)

b. Of the Intermediary (Luke 7:1 – 10)

c. Of the **Pray-ee** (Mark 5:25 – 34)



The Prayer of Faith (2-part Application)

i. Pray the Word

Psalm 107:20a
He sent forth His Word and healed
them ...

Proverbs 3:8 It (the Word) will be health to your flesh, and strength to your bones.



The Prayer of Faith (2-part Application)

i. Pray the Word

Romans 8:11
But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.



The Prayer of Faith (2-part Application)

ii. <u>Command and Rebuke</u> the sick condition e.g. the fever, the pain, the abnormal growth, etc.

Luke 4:39
So He bent over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her.
She got up at once ...



Mark 11:22 - 24 ²²So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God. ²³For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

- 4. Through <u>The Sacraments</u>
 - i. The **Anointing Oil**

Mark 6:13

And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed them.



- 4. Through <u>The Sacraments</u>
 - i. The **Anointing Oil**

James 5:14
Is anyone among you sick?
Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.
