
### Mark 11:23-24

So He stood over her and **rebuked** the **fever**, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them.




- 3. As kings, we speak to the mountain.
  - D. Speaking to the mountain is <u>NOT</u> speaking to God.
    - i. Speaking to God is prayer as a Priest.
    - Speaking to the mountain is your commanding and rebuking the mountain as a <u>King</u>.



- 3. As kings, we speak to the mountain.
  - E. As you speak to the mountain, you must not <u>doubt</u> in your heart.

Doubting comes when a thought, idea, picture, belief comes into our heart in the opposite direction of our faith in God thus nullifying our authority.
