1. **Decide** to bring unbroken praise to God at all times.

Psalm 34:1 (NIV) I will bless the Lord **at all times**; His praise shall **continually** be in my mouth.

Psalm 138:1-2

1 **I will** praise You with my whole heart; before the gods **I will** sing praises to You. **2** **I will** worship toward Your holy temple, and praise Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; for You have magnified Your word above all Your name.



2A. Praise brings us into the **courts** of God.

2C. Praise is preceded by confidence to come into the Presence of God by the Blood of Jesus and through the Lord Jesus, our High Priest.

Hebrews 10:19-22

19 Therefore, brethren, having boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Jesus, **20** by a new and living way which He consecrated for us, through the veil, that is, His flesh, **21** and having a High Priest over the house of God, **22** let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

Let us now appropriate the Blood and call on the Lord

3A. Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is.

Hebrews 13:15 Therefore by Him let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His Name/ confessing His Name / exalting His Name.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.

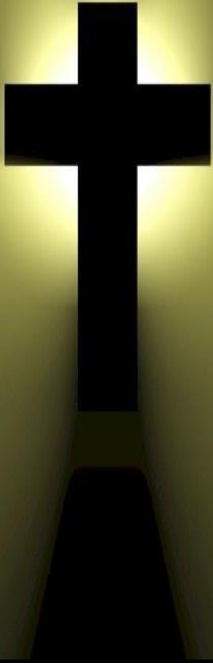

Psalm 103:1-2, 5b

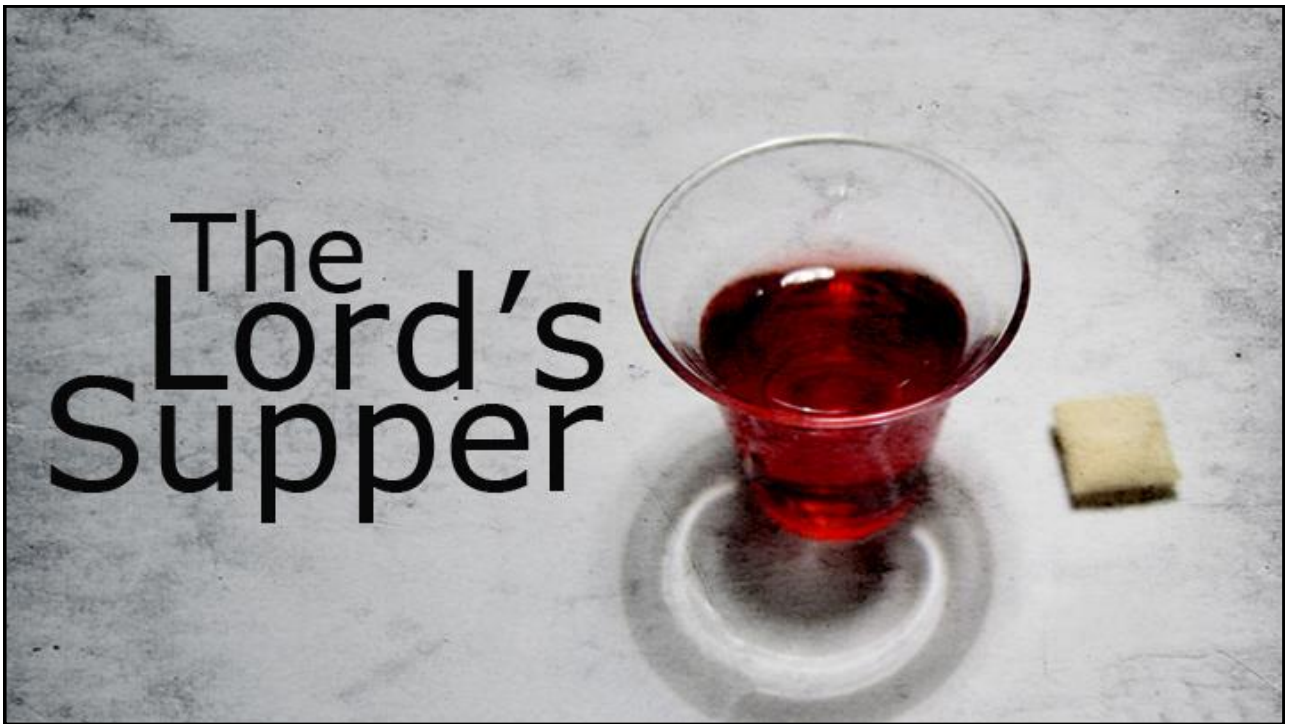

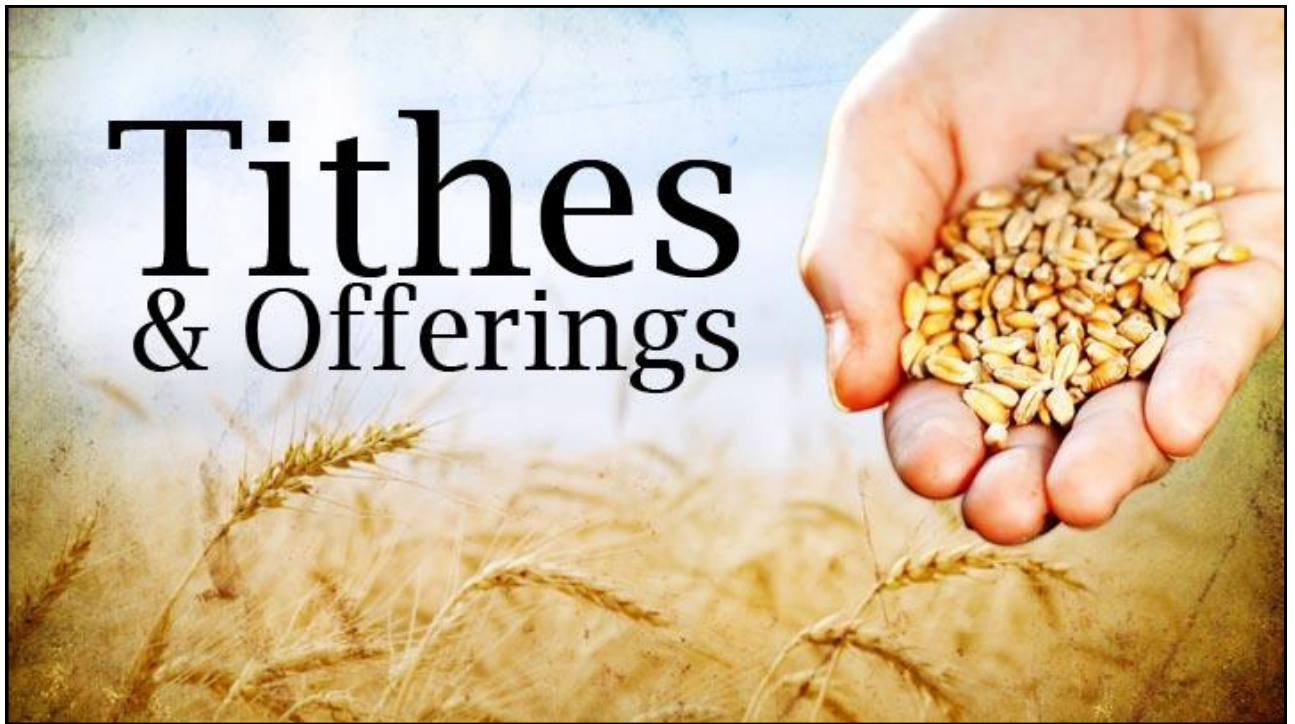

3A. Praise enables us to declare and proclaim who God is.

Psalm 23: The **7 Redemptive Names of God**:

- i. He is my **Jehovah-Rohi** who loved me and gave His life for me.
- ii. He is my **Jehovah-Shalom** the LORD, My Peace.
- iii. He is my **Jehovah-Tsidkenu** the LORD, My Righteousness.
- iv. He is my **Jehovah-Jireh** the LORD will provide.
- v. He is my **Jehovah-Rapha / Rophe** the LORD who heals.
- vi. He is my **Jehovah-Shammah** the LORD who is always there with me.
- vii. He is my **Jehovah-Nissi** the LORD, my Banner of Victory.

4A. Praise partners us with God to overcome our enemies and the enemies of God.

2 Chronicles 20:21-22

21 And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed those who should sing to the Lord, and who should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army and were saying: "Praise the Lord, for His mercy endures forever." **22** Now when they began to sing and to praise, the Lord set ambushes against the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir, who had come against Judah; and they were defeated.

Psalm 149:6-9

6 Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand, **7** to execute vengeance on the nations, and punishments on the peoples; **8** to bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; **9** to execute on them the written judgment — this honour have all His saints. Praise the Lord!

Matthew 5:44 But I say to you, love your enemies, bless those who curse you, do good to those who hate you, and pray for those who spitefully use you and persecute you ...

4B. Praise on the lips of our children will give us strength and will silence our enemies.

Psalm 8:2 (NIV) Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.

Pray for our children and strengthen our family altar.



5. Praise destroys yokes and burdens in our lives.

Acts 16:25-26

25 But about midnight when Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them; **26** suddenly there was a great earthquake, so [powerful] that the very foundations of the prison were shaken and at once all the doors were opened and everyone's chains were unfastened.

Present your yokes and burdens to the Lord

Genesis 29:35 And she conceived again and bore a son, and said, "**Now I will praise the Lord.**" Therefore she called his name Judah. Then she stopped bearing.

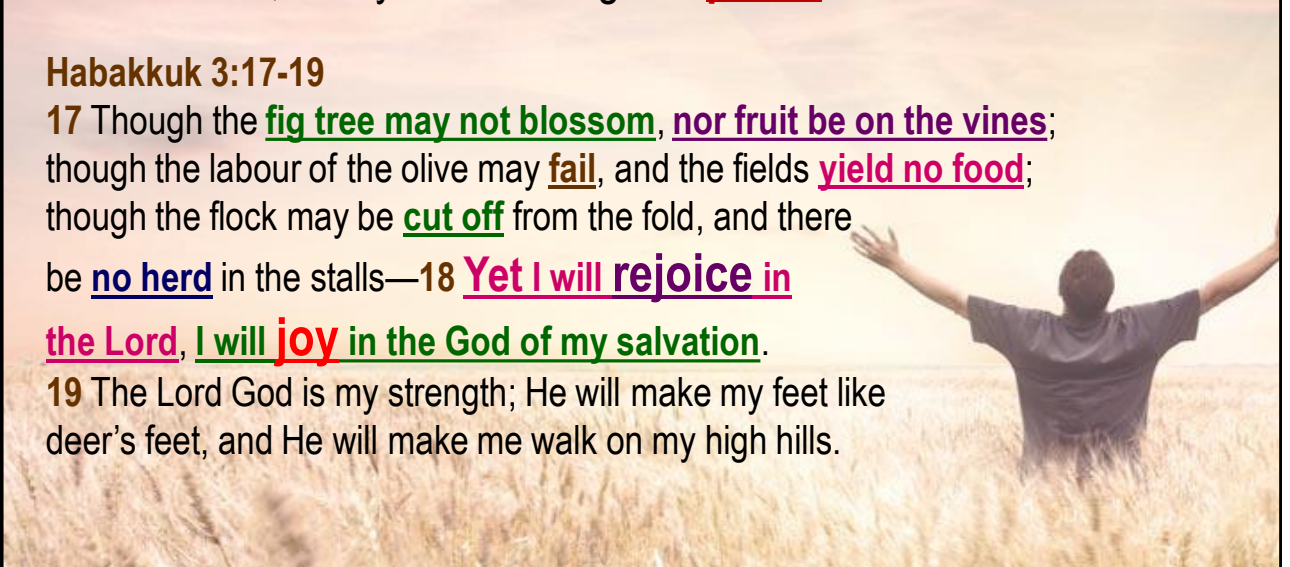


6. When we face **rejection** and are at the **bottom** of our lives and situations, a way out is to begin to **praise** the Lord.

Habakkuk 3:17-19

17 Though the **fig tree may not blossom**, **nor fruit be on the vines**; though the labour of the olive may **fail**, and the fields **yield no food**; though the flock may be **cut off** from the fold, and there be **no herd** in the stalls—**18 Yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will joy in the God of my salvation.**

7D. Praise is broken when we defile and profane the name of God.

Ezekiel 36:20-23

20 When they came to the nations, wherever they went, they profaned
My holy name—when they said of them, ‘These are the people of the Lord,
and yet they have gone out of His land.’ **21** But I had concern for
My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among
the nations wherever they went.

7D. Praise is broken when we defile and profane the name of God.

Ezekiel 36:20-23

22 “Therefore say to the house of Israel, ‘Thus says the Lord God: “I do not do this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name’s sake, which you have profaned among the nations wherever you went. **23** And I will sanctify My great name, which has been profaned among the nations, which you have profaned in their midst; and the nations shall know that I am the Lord,” says the Lord God, “when I am hallowed in you before their eyes.”

7E. Praise is broken when we bring unacceptable sacrifices to the Lord.

1 Peter 2:5 you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ.

Malachi 1:11 For from the rising of the sun, even to its going down, My name shall be great among the Gentiles; in every place incense shall be offered to My name, and a pure offering; for My name shall be great among the nations,” says the Lord of hosts.

Malachi 1:14 But cursed be the deceiver Who has in his flock a male, and takes a vow, but sacrifices to the Lord what is blemished—for I am a great King,” says the Lord of hosts, “and My name is to be feared among the nations.

7F. Praise is broken when we do not worship from our hearts.

Matthew 15:8 These people draw near to Me with their mouth, and honor Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me.

John 4:24 God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

Psalm 24:3-4

3 Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord?
Or who may stand in His holy place?

4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart,
Who has not lifted up his soul to an idol,
nor sworn deceitfully.
