Romans 1:21 Because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.







Worship - Romans 12:1 ... <u>present your bodies a living sacrifice</u>, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service.



















**C.** The Holy Spirit sharpening our **Discernment**.

In the New Testament, the Spirit of Prophecy is the <u>testimony</u> of Jesus.

- 1. Prophecies come in 2 broad ways:
  - (A) Speaking forth the Word of God.
  - (B) Foretelling through <u>spiritual gifts</u> like Word of Knowledge and Word of Wisdom.

- 2. The Fruit of Prophecy:
- 1 Corinthians 14:3 (NKJV) But he who prophesies speaks edification and exhortation and comfort to men.
- 1 Corinthians 14:3 (AMP) But [on the other hand], the one who prophesies [who interprets the divine will and purpose in inspired preaching and teaching] speaks to men for their upbuilding and constructive spiritual progress and encouragement and consolation.
