(2) Renewed Mind

Our mind must be daily renewed after the mind of Christ.

(Romans 12:1-2; Philippians 2:5; 1 Corinthians 2:16)

Inner-Man SOUL feelings jealousy (1) Natural Emotion lusts envy insecure impatience low self-image/esteem fits of rage easily swayed strife mood swings Cannot rejoice with other's success Need to boast / defend self

# e. Our <u>Natural</u> emotions must be <u>Spirit-Led</u>

#### (2) Spirit-Led Emotion

Our emotions must be surrendered to the Holy Spirit. He will temper our emotions ... to manifest the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> ... (Galatians 5:22 – 23)

## e. Our Natural will must be Yielded.

#### Inner-Man SOUL

(2) <u>Yielded</u> Will (Colossians 1:9-10) Our will must be aligned with God. We then have the knowledge, spiritual wisdom and spiritual understanding to make correct enlightened decision and choices.

<u>Decide</u> to run your race in life:2. To fulfill God's <u>Purpose</u> in your life and ministry.

This comes from clearly knowing and understanding the different **Roles** and **Responsibilities** you have. This will involve **ongoing learning and equipping of life-skills** to be effective and productive.

#### 2. To fulfill God's <u>Purpose</u> in your life and ministry.

This apply to our Life-Journey from YA to SC:-

- Studies, Relationships-BGR, Friendships, Establishing Career, Managing Finances.
- Building a Strong Marriage, Parenting Skills.
- Aging & Health Issues, Managing Finances, Relationships.

# To Ministry Skills of sharing Christ as we mature in Him.

II. We must grasp the life-<u>Principle/Truth</u> on issues and not get entangled over methodologies.

e.g. 1 - Apply mud over eyes for sight?
e.g. 2 - Anointing Oil
e.g. 3 - High Quest

III. We must get out of religion [rituals – performance treadmill] to developing our <u>Relationship</u> with God.

**Religious duties without relationship with God:-** Attending Church Attending a CG Meeting Serving as Hands & Feet Getting Baptized Partaking the Lord's Supper ✓ Have a leader pray over you.



#### 1 Peter 2:2-3

<sup>2</sup>as newborn babes, desire the pure <u>milk</u> <u>of the word</u>, that you may grow thereby, <sup>3</sup>if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is gracious.

The **GOAL** of the intake of the **MILK** of the Word is to **EXPERIENCE** the reality of the Promises of God / Word in your life.

#### Matthew 4:4

But He answered and said, "It is written, 'Man shall not live by


bread alone, but by every word

The <u>GOAL</u> of the intake of the <u>BREAD</u> of the Word is to regularly hear what the Lord is <u>SPEAKING</u> to you in your daily living.

#### Hebrews 5:14

But <u>solid food</u> belongs to those who are of full age, that is, those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.



The <u>GOAL</u> of the intake of the <u>MEAT</u> of the Word is to sharpen <u>DISCERNMENT</u> as you apply the Word to the situations of your life.

2 broad Interpretation of Scriptures:-1. Literal Application The text is historical and true in its context. Good information and knowledge. This is the **LOGOS** - the **Written Word**.

2 broad Interpretation of Scriptures: Spiritual Application
 This is when the text speaks to us personally in the context of our life-issues.
 This is the RHEMA - the Living Word.

2 broad Interpretation of Scriptures:2. Spiritual Application
e.g. 1 - Jeremiah 29:11

#### Jeremiah 29:11

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the LORD, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope.

2 broad Interpretation of Scriptures:-2. Spiritual Application e.g. 2 - Holy Communion - The Bread [Body] and the Wine [Blood] - Do this remembrance of ME - Proclaim the Lord's Death until He comes

 broad Interpretation of Scriptures: Spiritual Application
 Ephesians 1:17 - Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation in the knowledge of Him.

#### 2 Corinthians 3:6

who also made us sufficient as ministers of the new covenant, not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.

People are more important than tasks V. Encourage and Build Lives - Relationships with people more important than tasks - Edify, Exhort, Comfort - in the CG

- V. **<u>People</u> are more important than** tasks
  - Relationships involve:-
    - No offenses
    - Understanding **Personality** and **Work-Style** differences.
    - Understanding the corruption of the carnal flesh vs spiritual life

#### John 5:19

Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **the Son** can do nothing of Himself, but what **He sees the Father do**; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

Luke 4:25-26 Many widows but Elijah sent to only one

Luke 4:27 Many lepers but Elisha healed only Naaman

VI. Focus on what God is doing instead of what He is not doing.

John 5:1-15 **Pool of Bethesda** - Only one healed by the Lord Jesus -

VII. Only a life of Faith pleases God.

Hebrews 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

VII. Only a life of Faith pleases God.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:7 For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Romans 14:23 But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because he does not eat from faith; for whatever is not from faith is sin.

VII. Only a life of Faith pleases God.

#### 1 John 3:22-23

<sup>22</sup>And whatever we ask we receive from Him, because we keep His commandments and do those things that are pleasing in His sight. <sup>23</sup>And this is **His commandment**: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment.
