

### Introduction

**2 Timothy 2:22** (NKJV) **Flee** also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

**2 Timothy 2:22** (NLT) **Run** from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts.

## Definition - Wings

- II. Understand that <u>desire</u> is stronger than will power.
  - 1. Understand <u>how</u> a person falls into temptation.

#### James 1:13-15

14 But <u>each one is tempted</u> when he is <u>drawn away</u> by his own desires and enticed. 15 Then, <u>when desire</u> has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and <u>sin</u>, when it is <u>full-grown</u>, <u>brings forth death</u>.

James 1:14-15 But each one is <u>tempted</u> when he is drawn away by his <u>own desires</u> and <u>enticed</u>. Then, when <u>desire has conceived</u>, it gives birth to <u>sin</u>; and sin, when it is full-<u>grown</u>, brings forth <u>death</u>.





2. Our <u>desires</u> must be circumscribed by <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u>.

Jeremiah 9:24 But let him who glories glory in this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord, exercising lovingkindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth. For in these I delight," says the Lord.

**Psalm 97:2b** ... **<u>Righteousness and justice</u>** are the foundation of His throne.



 Our <u>desires</u> must be circumscribed by <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u>.
 e.g. 1: For <u>Food</u>

Philippians 3:19 whose end is destruction, whose god is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame—who set their mind on earthly things.

Hebrews 12:16 lest there be any <u>fornicator or profane</u> person like Esau, <u>who for one morsel of food</u> <u>sold his birth-right</u>.



 Our <u>desires</u> must be circumscribed by <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u>.
 e.g. 2: For <u>Sex</u>

Hebrews 13:4 Marriage is honorable among <u>all</u>, and the bed undefiled; but <u>fornicators and adulterers</u> <u>God will judge</u>.



 Our <u>desires</u> must be circumscribed by <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u>.
 e.g. 3: For <u>Money</u>

#### 1 Timothy 6:6-10

6 Now godliness with contentment is great gain.
7 For we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we can carry nothing out. 8 And having food and clothing, with these we shall be content.



 Our <u>desires</u> must be circumscribed by <u>justice</u> and <u>righteousness</u>.
 e.g. 3: For <u>Money</u>

#### 1 Timothy 6:6-10

9 But those who desire to be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and harmful lusts which drown men in destruction and perdition. 10 For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.





A. Daily <u>consecrate</u> the areas of our lives to God as instruments of <u>righteousness</u> unto holiness.

Romans 6:13 And do not present your members as instruments of unrighteousness to sin, but <u>present</u> <u>yourselves to God</u> as being alive from the dead, <u>and your members as</u> <u>instruments of righteousness to God</u>.









- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 3. Learn to take captive every <u>thought</u> and <u>suggestion</u> in obedience to Christ.

2 Corinthians 10:5 (NIV) We demolish <u>arguments</u> and <u>every pretension</u> that <u>sets itself up against the</u> <u>knowledge of God</u>, and we <u>take captive every thought</u> <u>to make it obedient to Christ</u>.











- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 4. When tempted Flee like <u>Joseph</u>.

#### Genesis 39:6b-12

6 ... Now Joseph was handsome in form and appearance.
7 And it came to pass after these things that his master's wife cast longing eyes on Joseph, and she said, "Lie with me."
8 But he <u>refused</u> and said to his master's wife, "Look, my master does not know what is with me in the house, and he has committed all that he has to my hand. 9 There is no one greater in this house than I, nor has he kept back anything from me but you, because you are his wife. <u>How then can</u> I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?"



- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 4. When tempted Flee like <u>Joseph</u>.

#### Genesis 39:6b-12

10 So it was, as <u>she spoke to Joseph day by day</u>, <u>that he</u> <u>did not heed her</u>, to lie with her or to be with her. 11 But it happened about this time, when Joseph went into the house to do his work, and none of the men of the house was inside, 12 that she caught him by his garment, saying, "Lie with me." But <u>he left his garment in her hand</u>, <u>and fled and ran</u> <u>outside</u>.



- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 5. When tempted Do not be like David.

#### 2 Samuel 11:1-4

 It happened in the spring of the year, at the time when kings go out to battle, that David sent Joab and his servants ... But David remained at Jerusalem.
 Then it happened one evening that David arose from his bed and walked on the roof of the king's house.
 And from the roof he saw a woman bathing, and the woman was very beautiful to behold.



- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 5. When tempted Do not be like **David**.

#### 2 Samuel 11:1-4

3 So <u>David sent and inquired about the woman</u>. And someone said, "Is this not Bathsheba, the daughter of Eliam, the wife of Uriah the Hittite?" 4 Then <u>David sent</u> <u>messengers</u>, and <u>took her</u>; and she came to him, and <u>he</u> <u>lay with her</u>, for she was cleansed from her impurity; and she returned to her house.

**2 Samuel 11:27c** ... But the thing that David had done **displeased the Lord**.





- **III.** Plan to walk victoriously from the start:
  - 7. If married, grow in **<u>intimacy</u>** with your spouse.

#### Genesis 2:24-25

24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.
25 And they were both naked, the man and his wife, and were not ashamed.

Amos 3:3 Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?
