

Matthew 14:22-24


And straightway Jesus constrained his disciples to get into a ship, and to go before him unto the other side, while he sent the multitudes away.


a. Exhaustion - they are worn out.


Bible has records of Unforgettable walks

1 Man is given the choice of the destination he wants to go, but God chooses the route.





2 When God seems silent and absent, He is actively praying that your faith will not fail.



3 Although God's help & resources might be near, they must be invited and activated through faith and action.









Happiness is external. Joy is internal.

Four Things about Joy 1. Joy is learned 2. Joy is all about perspective 3. Joy & gratefulness go hand in hand 4. Worry is a killjoy






